



2020 SEASON PARENT AND SPECTATOR CHECKLIST

PARENTS

- Do not allow your player to participate if any of the following is true:
 - Display **ANY** of the common COVID-19 symptoms: fever, cough, headaches, aches and pains, sore throat, chills, runny nose, loss of sense of taste or smell, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing.
 - Travelled internationally within the last 14 days.
 - Close contact with a confirmed or probable COVID-19 case, that you are aware of.
- Respect the rules and guidelines set out by MJLL regarding the 2020 season.
- Ensure players arrive no more than five to 10 minutes before they are scheduled to reduce people gathering in groups.
- Ensure each player has their own:
 - Equipment – Glove, helmet and where possible a bat
 - Water bottle
 - Hand sanitizer
 - Understand how to social distance and sanitize
 - Has a means of transportation (note, ride sharing is discouraged)
- Sunflower seeds and gum are not allowed and should not be sent with players:
- Sign-in the player with the coach along with who is attending with the player (one person can sign in for everyone). You will also answer 3 yes / no questions:
 1. Do you have ANY of the common COVID-19 symptoms: fever, cough, headaches, aches and pains, sore throat, chills, runny nose, loss of sense of taste or smell, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing?
 2. Have you travelled internationally within the last 14 days?
 3. Have you had any close contact with a confirmed or probable COVID-19 case, that you are aware of?

SPECTATORS

- Most important rule is to follow the Government of Saskatchewan's rule on social distancing (6 feet) and sanitizing.
- Follow all signage at the ball diamond
- Sanitize your hand upon arrival and upon departure.
- Ensure no more than the maximum number of people permitted in outdoor gatherings are being observed.
 - *As of opening day the maximum is 30. Those on-field, home team spectators and visiting team spectators are each considered their own group and allowed up to 30 people each meaning each game / practice can have up to 90 people in total.*
- Do not move between ball diamonds and stay at only one when spectating.
- Do not touch any maintenance or sport equipment
