Policy for jerseys are as follows:

- Players may only wear their jerseys for scheduled games or for other special events as requested by the coach or team manager. Game jerseys may never be worn to practice, school or other jersey day events.
- At no time may a player/parent alter or change the original shape or form of the jersey.
- Name bars, sponsor bars and letters (C, A) are NOT permitted.
- Jerseys should never be placed in the gear bag unless they are placed in an alternate protective bag first (plastic bags are not acceptable). The use of a garment bag is strongly encouraged. Doyle Corporate Image sells garment bags at a cost of \$25 plus tax and protective cinch bags at a cost of \$17 plus tax.
- Washing instructions:
 - -It is strongly encouraged that jerseys be washed after each game, separate from other clothing, in cold water, delicate cycle and hung to dry.
 - -Do not ever iron jerseys.

•	It is the parent's responsibility upon receiving the jersey to report any noticeable damage in the space provided below and submit photos of the damage to the team manager. Otherwise, it will be assumed that any damage not reported is the responsibility of the parent.
