## Moose Jaw Minor Hockey Billet Coordinator – Volunteer Position

Moose Jaw Minor Hockey is seeking a Billet Coordinator for the 2025-26 season. This volunteer role will support the U15 AA, U16 AA, and U18 AA teams by coordinating billet arrangements for players who require local housing during the season.

**Key Responsibilities:** • Recruit, screen, and select billet

families to host players.

- Serve as the main contact for both players and billet families, addressing any questions or concerns.
- Matching hosts with players - Ensure compatibility between hosts and players, considering preferences and requirements.
- Managing logistics - Oversee transportation arrangements and any special needs.
- Monitoring and Support - Provide ongoing support to both the hosts and players, addressing any concerns or issues.
- Background checks - Obtaining required background checks and contacting references if required.

### Qualifications:

- Strong Organizational skills - Ability to manage multiple accommodations, schedules and logistical details for 3 AA teams.
- Communication skills - Strong verbal and written communication skills to effectively communicate with MJMH, players, coaches, hosts etc..
- Interpersonal skills - Ability to build relationships with the community and participants.
- Problem solving skills - Capable of addressing issues that may arise with accommodations, such as conflicts or last minute changes.
- Flexibility and adaptability - Willingness to adjust plans as needed to accommodate changes in schedules or requirements.
- Knowledge of the local area - Familiarity with the local area to provide appropriate accommodation options and resources.
- Previous experience in a coordination role is an asset but not required
