Cancellation Policy

- **Withdrawal after April 15th:** Teams will receive only half of their registration fees. Refunding full amount minus \$25 admin fee if we fill the spot with another team. This encourages teams to help find replacements, optimizing our time and maintaining revenue in case of a withdrawal.
- **Withdrawal before April 15th:** Teams will be refunded all fees except for a \$25 administration fee.

Tournament Format

- **Game Guarantee:** * **Mad Greek (A):** Each team is guaranteed **four (4)** games.
 - **Crushed Can Annual:** Each team is guaranteed **three (3)** games.
- **Round Robin:** Games will be played in a round-robin format to determine playoff seeding.
- **Playoffs:** Will be determined based on number of teams entered.
- **Finals:** Each tournament category will conclude with a Gold Medal game.

Tournament Rules & Regulations

All games will follow the official rules established by **Softball Saskatchewan**.

Crushed Can Annual Rules (B/C Divisions)

All rules follow the **2025 Softball Saskatchewan Handbook** with the following exceptions:

- **Time Limit:** Games have a **1 hour 45 minute** total limit. No new inning shall start after **1 hour and 30 minutes** from the start of the game.
- **Batting:** The "**Everybody Bats**" rule will be used in all games.\
- **Max runs:** per inning will be u11-3, u13-5, u15-5
- **Home Team:** Determined by the official tournament schedule.
- **Scorekeeping:** The **Home Team** is responsible for supplying the scorekeeper.

Mad Greek Rules (A Divisions)

All rules follow the **2025 Softball Saskatchewan Handbook** with the following exceptions:

- **Time Limit:** Games have a **1 hour 45 minute** total limit. No new inning shall start after **1 hour and 30 minutes** from the start of the game.
- **Roster:** Teams in U13 and up can choose to use a **nine-man roster**, and those specific rules will apply.
- **Home Team:** Determined by the official tournament schedule.

- **Scorekeeping:** The **Home Team** is responsible for supplying the scorekeeper.

General Information

- **Communication:** Any tournament-specific adjustments (scheduling or game management) will be communicated by the tournament committee.
- **Park Etiquette:** Please help us keep our facilities clean by ensuring dugouts are clear of all trash after each game.
- **Conduct:** Coaches and players are expected to demonstrate high sportsmanship and respect toward umpires, opponents, and volunteers.

Note: In the event of a dispute, the Tournament Committee's decision is final.
