Moose Jaw FC teams compete locally and provincially, but we hope to expand to compete nationally and possibly internationally, subject to dedication.

Moose Jaw FC does not hold tryouts. Our requirement to be part of our FC program is the desire to increase individual soccer skills and a desire to commit to being a part of a team.

U7 & U9 Learn to FC \$50.00 in addition to Grassroots pricing.	1 training session per week with tournament entry at the discretion of Coaches.
Under 11 & Under 13 FC \$245	Minimum 2 training sessions per week with tournament entry at the discretion of Coaches. Official fees for games included.
Under 15-19 FC \$265	Minimum 2 training sessions per week with tournament entry at the discretion of Coaches. Official fees for games included.
Tournament/League Play	Moose Jaw FC teams register for tournaments throughout the season that are NOT covered in player registration fees.
Goalkeeper Training \$50	MJSA members age 8+ may register for our new Goalkeeper Training. *subject to minimum numbers*

<p>U5 - 45 minute session, Parent Participation, Mini Activities. U7 and U9 - 25 minute practice, 25 minute game. U11 and U13 - 25 minute practice, 30 minute game (teams will be made by mixing players registered in grassroots) *No games played against other clubs</p> <p>Adult Co-Ed - 2 X 25 minute halves, 6v6 min, must have two female players on the field at all times. Men's or Women's Pickup - MUST be registered in Adult Co-ed to receive \$40 price (Can opt for Pickup only but Co-ed Individual fee of \$110 applies)</p>

Requests will be reviewed on a player by player basis.</p> <p>The MJSA reserves the right to mix age groups and/or genders in order to form leagues that are feasible and competitive overall, as well as cancelling programming if insufficient registrations and lack of volunteerism occurs. Our best efforts will be made in order to keep age groups and genders separate. Team roster adjustments maybe made throughout the season in order to keep team performance levels balanced. In order to encourage volunteerism within the organization, each player is subject to pay a \$50.00 volunteer bond. Exceptions are to families who only have U5 or younger participants or adult players who don't have kids in MJSA programs.</p>
