

Mount Pearl Soccer Association Privacy Policy

The Mount Pearl Soccer Association (MPSA) has developed this privacy document in order to demonstrate our firm commitment to the privacy of our members. The following discloses our information collection and distribution practices.

Personal information is information about an identifiable individual and includes information that relates to their personal characteristics (e.g., gender, age, home address or phone number, ethnic background, family status), their health (e.g., health history, health conditions, health services received by them), their competitive performance or their activities and views (e.g., religion, politics, opinions expressed by an individual, an opinion or evaluation of an individual).

Personal information, however, does not include business contact information (e.g., an individual's business address and telephone number).

The MPSA Board is responsible for the organization's handling of personal information and ensuring that all staff receives appropriate training on the proper handling of confidential/private information.

Personal information will only be collected, used and disclosed by MPSA to engage players, parents, board members, coaches, officials and other volunteers in the programs and activities offered by MPSA.

By providing personal information to the MPSA, individuals are consenting to the use of the information for the purposes identified in this policy. Individuals may consent to the collection and use of personal information in a number of ways, including the following:

- Completing and/or signing a registration form or an application form;
- Providing written consent either physically or electronically;
- Consenting orally in person; or
- Consenting orally over the phone.

Personal information is used for purposes directly related to the activities of the MPSA including:

- Registration purposes with the Mt. Pearl Soccer Association (MPSA), Newfoundland Soccer Association (NLSA), Canadian Soccer Association (CSA) or various soccer Leagues in which a member participate;
- Team organizational purposes;
- Administrative purposes, including payroll, scholarships, awards;
- Communications;
- Purchasing equipment and other products;
- Travel arrangements;
- Medical needs;
- Insurance requirements; and
- Promotional photography.

Members may withdraw consent related to their personal information at any time, by contacting the MPSA Office at mpsasoccer@bellaliant.com or by calling (709) 364-9793. MPSA will not sell or distribute your personal information to any other third party not listed herein.

MPSA may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external organizations about a particular offering that may be of interest to you (e.g. soccer camps). Periodically, you may receive periodic brochures from us with information on upcoming events.
