

RAMP GAMESHEETS instructions – Officials

To access RAMP GAMESHEETS

- ALL officials MUST download the RAMP GAMESHEET APP (free) on their smartphone or tablet. Depending on the device, the APP can be found in the Google Play Store the APP Store.
- Once the APP is downloaded (1st screen below), you will have to create a personal account by selecting CREATE ACCOUNT. Enter your personal information (2nd screen below). This account is not tied to a team or an association. It is your personal account.

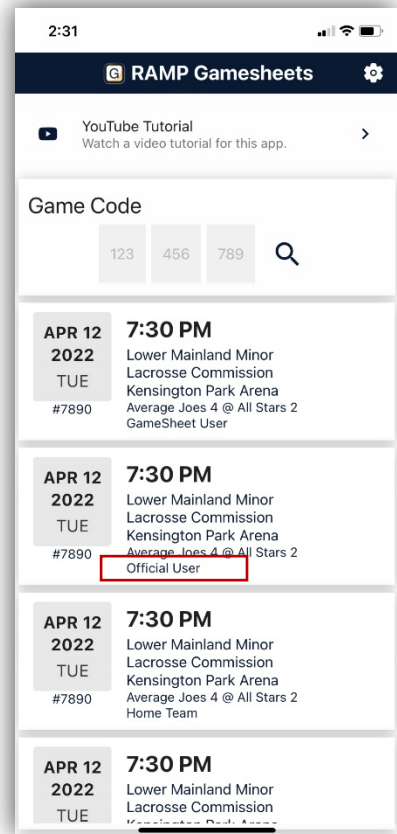
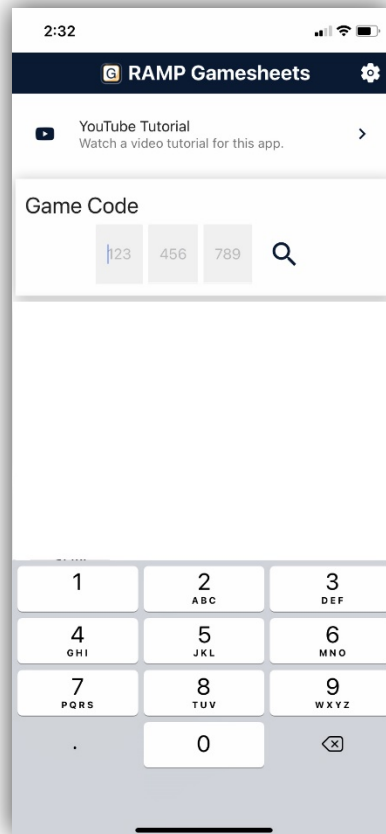
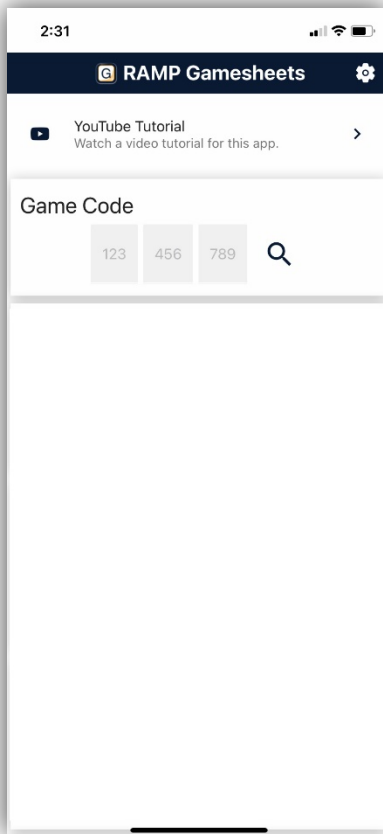

RAMP GAMESHEETS instructions – Officials

Entering codes

- When you sign into the APP, you will see your home screen (1st screen below).
- The home team manager will provide you with the Official User Code for the game. **Each game will have its own, unique code.**
- You must enter the Official User Code when you have access to Wi-Fi or the internet so the game information will load onto your device.
 - Even if you have spotty (or no) WIFI during the game, the APP will automatically save the information and it will upload the next time the device has internet connection/WIFI.
- From the APP home screen, enter the Official User Code (2nd screen below).
 - Tap on the search button and your game will appear on your home screen (3rd screen below).
 - The last line of each section indicates which code it is for (GameSheet User, Official User, Home Team, Visiting Team).
 - As a referee, you will be using the Official User code.






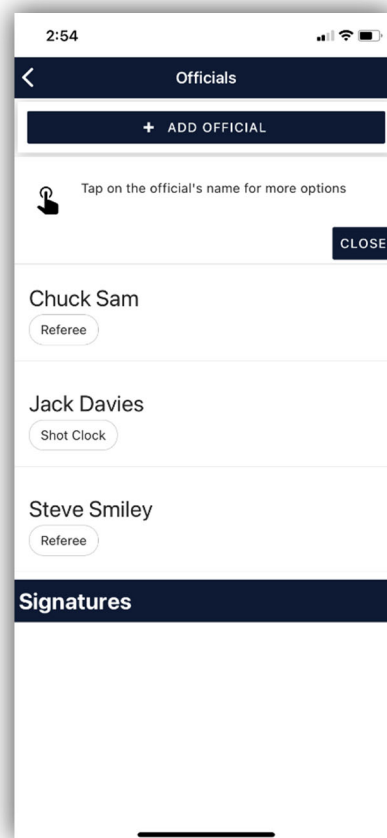
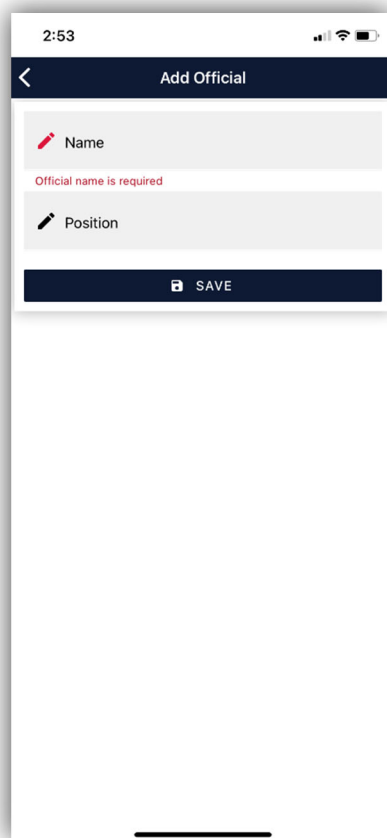
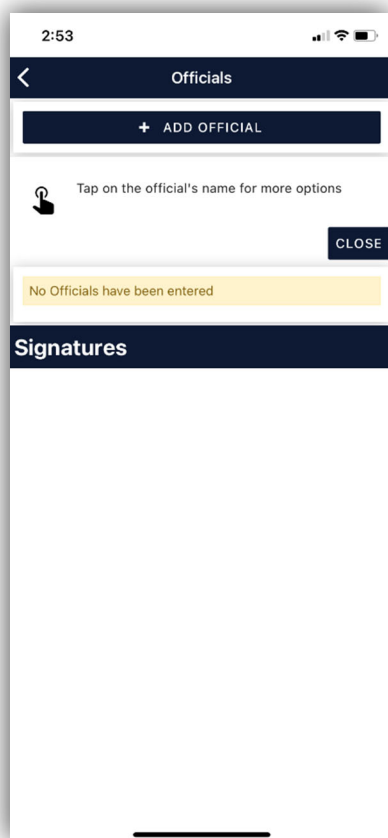
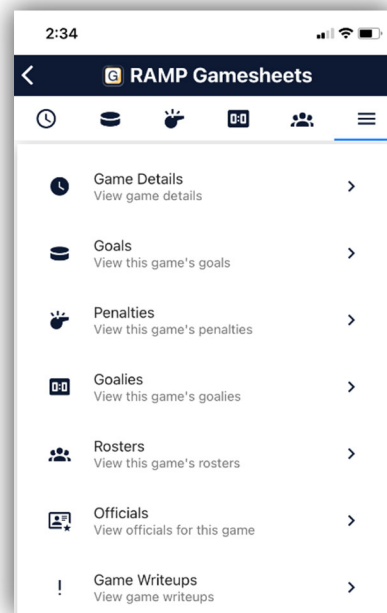

Before the game

Add names

The home team manager may assist you with this but must be logged in with the Official User Code to do so. It is preferred that officials add their own names.

- From the home screen, select the game you will be officiating.
- Once on the Game Details page, select the  icon (screen to right), then Officials (1st screen below).
- Select the  button, add your Name and Position (2nd screen below) then select the  button. You will be able to see all the officials listed (3rd screen below).

Review game details

You can review all the information entered for the game:

Goals tab

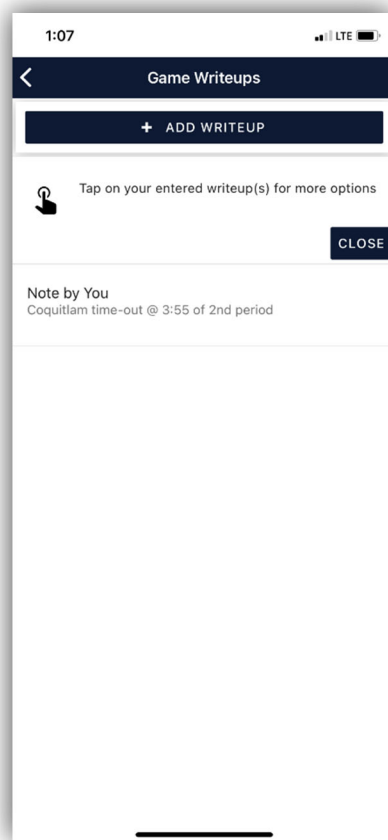
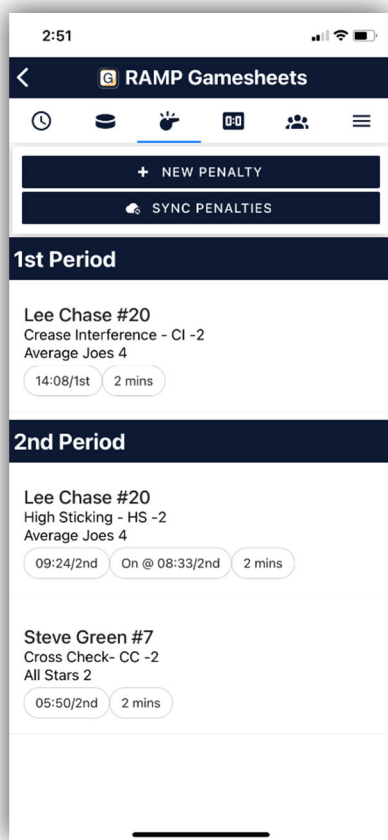
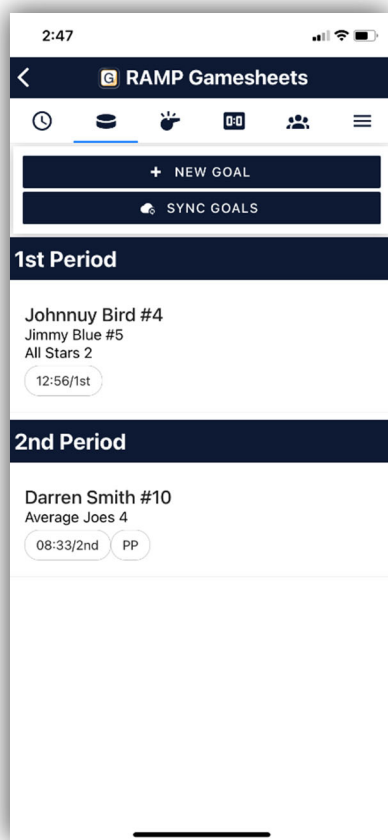
- On this tab you will be able to view any goals scored by period/time (1st screen below).

Penalties tab

- On this tab you will be able to view any penalties assessed by period/time (2nd screen below).

More tab




- Under the More tab then Game Writeups, you will be able to view any game notes added by the scorekeeper (3rd screen below).

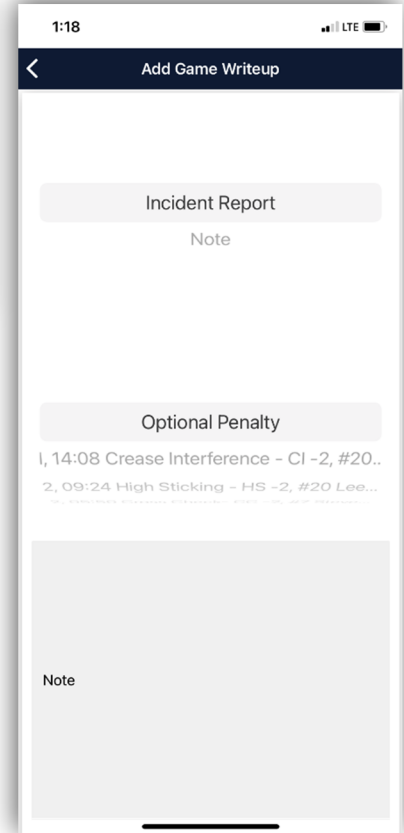
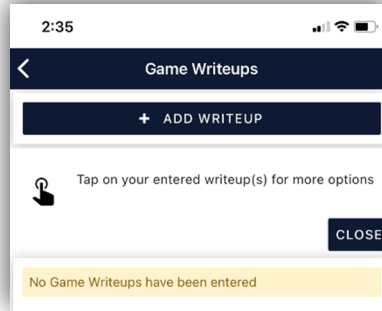


RAMP GAMESHEETS instructions – Officials




Game writeup (if applicable)

If a game writeup is required:

- Select the  icon, then Game Writeups (1st screen to the right).
- Select the  button (2nd screen to the right). This is where you will add any writeups or game notes.
- For a game writeup, select Incident Report, enter the details in the Note field, and select the  button.



Game sheet sign-off

- Select the  icon, Officials, then the  button (1st screen to right).
- You can use your finger to sign the screen and select the  button.

Note: if you use the scorekeeper's device, there will only be room for one signature. Each official must sign in with your own account and enter the Official Code to sign separately.

- Once signed, your signatures will be visible in the Officials section (2nd screen to right).
