- Jerseys

 - Jersey provider has gone out of business
 - We'll have to source somewhere that can match exactly
 - Prepare to have changes
 - Suggestion of Rep teams purchasing Jerseys brought up again but no concensus
 - Interesting
 - King Sportswear bought a bunch of blank jerseys for stock
 - Skater's North subcontracts jersey replacements from King
 - QC not great as reported by Paul McLean
 - Chris and Shauna suggested affiliating with Lakers or Battalion
 - May lead to jersey colours changing

Chris will be addressing this with him soon



- May also provide subsidy for the league based on understanding of deals with other Associations
 - Jeff thought Nipissing's budget might not allow for it due to COVID setbacks

Scheduler's Update:

- All games scheduled so far
 - o Waiting on U9 full-ice schedule
- There are some openings in January contract
 - Saturday 7:45 9:45 consistently
- TimeKeepers
 - o Made it through Nov
 - Most of December is filled
 - Just waiting to hear back from some experienced time keepers
- ***Tangent
 - Mike asked what league U9, U11, U13 House are in
 - No league
 - Jeff said that a league constitution would cover disputes should there be any
 - Lucas added that they are using OWHA rules



 Chris mentioned that there are no RAMP on shared iPADs Mike to confirm for Jeff where paper game sheets are entered electronically

Competitive Update:

- Teams running well
- Dave Wilson's team is now running well
- NDHL meeting (attended by Mike for Jeff)
 - Some games cancelled for COVID
 - Looking at Super Weekend for first weekend in April
 - Mike brought the concern of conflicts with Provincials for OWHA
- U11 A is now competitive within their category, so Chris Kendrick's previous request is officially closed

House League Update:

- Going well
- Planned games with Sudbury are on hold due to COVID
- Almaguin is working with NBGHA on having a Jamboree in South River for March 19th
 - A planning committee will be formed of coaches and convenors from both Associations
- Proposal: March 5th skills competition
 - Exec approved this
 - o There is a 4 hour block available
 - Lucas will put together a proposal
 - Jeff's suggestions
 - Canadore has equipment to measure player speed
 - Powasson has radar for shot speed
 - It may also be a good thing for our Association to purchase one



Registrar's Update:

- See Report from Paul attached in different email
- OWHA is still having problems with HCR profiles synching
 - Staff and coaches have been providing me with pictures of their certifications and I've been forwarding those on to the OWHA Registrar
 - The problems are solved very quickly
- COVID Proof of Vaccination
 - From the first email, I received and scanned over 120 verifications
 - Staff
 - Paul manually queried staff as there were only 85 to go through
 - Paul sent a reminder email from that list
 - Many of those that needed reminding were from the Rep teams
 - There are still 33 staff outstanding
- Mike has been contacted about a Senior Team for tournaments and maybe provincials
- Lucas has been contacted by 42 players to form a senior league under the IceBoltz
 - Jeff suggested reaching out to find out what the intent of the league is: Official Games or just organized shinny without officials
 - Paul can set up packages for league and competitive team
 - Unanimous vote to move ahead with the league

- Paul pull a report from RAMP of those that hadn't provided proof, but there was no way to do so
 - Paul spoke with RAMP and they are working on a solution
 - Paul will send a further email on Friday
- A/I Paul to add Lucas as coach and Mike as voter to get team approved

- Populating Practices will post to our website and RAMP Team
- One (Association Login) will allow you to add games, which are then populated in RAMP GameSheet
 - Populating games with the Association Login, will also post those games and stats to the OWHA website as well as our website along with RAMP Team
- Paul has sent the Association code to add games to most teams
- Mike commented that we were invoiced \$300 from RAMP
 - Paul has it in writing that it was a part of our package
