



# Nepean Girls Hockey Association (NGHA) Nepean Wildcats



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## Permission to Tryout and Player Release

### Purpose

The NGHA supports and follows the OWSA Regulations and Policies governing player movement and Release in the context of OWSA Regulations and Policies governing recruitment and Tampering. The NGHA Permission to Tryout and Player Release Policy establishes the eligibility and process to be followed if applying for a Permission to Tryout or Player Release for NGHA players.

### General

A Permission to Tryout and/or Release will not be issued to a player who has not fulfilled her financial obligations to the NGHA or who has not returned all NGHA equipment and jerseys.

### Player Release Eligibility

A Release will be given to a player wishing to try out or play for a team with another OWSA Association at a level that the NGHA has a team, except for U22 elite teams in which case a Permission to Tryout form may be issued.

A player who receives a Release will not be eligible to return to NGHA during the season in which Release was granted.

### Request for Player Release

A Release can only be completed by the NGHA President.

To request a release, email the appropriate contact emails below indicating that the player is requesting a release.

Requests must be submitted in this format only. Verbal requests will not be processed. Incomplete information will result in delays in processing your requests. You will receive your notification by email.



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## Permission to Tryout Eligibility

A permission to tryout (PTT) form must be used when a player wishes to attend a tryout hosted by another OWHA association or OWHA independent team.

The NGHA will not issue a Permission to Tryout form for any NGHA player for competitive tryouts with another OWHA team for the fall/ winter season where the NGHA has a team at that level. NGHA players wanting to try out for another OWHA team at a level that the NGHA has a team, must apply for a release. The only exception to the rule is for NGHA U18 players wanting to try out for a U22 elite team, in which case a Permission to Tryout form may be issued.
