- Clear any risk of further harm to the injured person by securing the are and the injured person
- Designate who is in charge of other participants
- Assess ABCs (Airway, Breathing, Circulation)
- Apply First Aid as required
- Wait with the injured person until EMS arrives and injured person is transported
- Fill in an accident report form

- Call for emergency help (9-1-1)
- Provide all necessary info to dispatch (location, nature of injury, what First Aid has been provided
- Clear any traffic from entrance / access road before ambulance arrives
- Wait by the driveway entrance to the facility to direct the ambulance when it arrives
- Call the emergency contact person for the player

A First Aid Kit is always on the bench during practices, game, and tournaments. Parental contact information and medical information sheets are kept with the team Manager, and with the Trainer. Copies of this Emergency Action Plan have been given to Managers and designated Call Persons. All Bench Staff have been made aware of significant medical conditions.
