NEUSC actively looks for and encourages female coaches across all our programs, we are very fortunate to have a very balanced male to female coaches' ratio and we endeavour to maintain this. With the help of the NLSA and other association club members we encourage and look to have our female coaches and volunteers participate in female mentorship programs run in the province.
