(Continued)	Game Time Warm up: Core and Stretch with addition of mind/body energy thoughts (positive messages)
	<b>3 Skills Clinics</b> (included as part of player registration): for these clinics we are trying to bring in experiences players/ instructors to correctly demonstrate skills to players and coaches
	<b>Team Budget</b> : Minimum of 1 hour full ice booking to run a skills or game development type of practice
	<ul> <li>In addition NDRA will be running self-funded development skills, skating and goalie development camps:</li> </ul>
	Self-Funded Pre-Season (September 2014) skills/power skating/goalie camp for U8 to U19 players

New Business	Boy players in Ringette
	Currently boys are allowed to play Ringette up to and including the age level of U12 Regional
	<ul> <li>There is still discussion in ORA to allow boys to play up to the U12 Provincial level though many associations have voiced that they do not agree with this move and it will be reviewed at the ORA AGM again this year</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>NDRA's position is that we do not agree with the boy players at the U12 Provincial level</li> </ul>

Open Discussion	When is the cutoff date for registration
	- Currently there is no cutoff date to register a player in NDRA though we do have a cutoff date as to when the TRF can no longer be altered
	• Can we make pre-season Power Skating in August/September mandatory for our players? Perhaps increasing the registration fee would cover some of this cost and be a push for players to attend?
	<ul> <li>Pre-Season practices cannot be made mandatory. The official start to our season is October so any skating or practices before this cannot be made mandatory. There is a possibility of moving the start of our season to September to allow for extra practices before the first games commence. This is something the BoD would need to examine for the 2015/2016 season as registration fees and season start dates have already been announced for the 2014/2015 season.</li> </ul>
	- Coaches and Teams are encouraged to obtain and pay for extra ice time prior to the start of the season on their own but attendance cannot be made mandatory by the coaches.
	Would like to see a Survey be sent to the parents/families in regards to extra skate time/training/costs
	- The BoD is working on a survey that will be sent out to the families of the association to get feedback on what type of extra training/ice time they would like to see and to determine what type of costs they would be comfortable with
	<ul> <li>If Teams/Coaches were to organize skills/skating training on their own would the BoD consider paying for a certain percentage of the cost to make this more attainable?</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>This is something the BoD will need to consider and discuss in the near future and will be placed on the agenda</li> <li>The BoD will ask Murdock to reach out the coaches of the upcoming season with recommendations for skating instructors if they do chose to purchase extra ice time</li> </ul>
