

Fundraising Policy

Definition

Activities that are intended to generate revenue for the Association as a whole or an individual team.

Approval

All fundraising activities must be submitted to the NDRA board for approval and receive approval from the board before starting the fundraising activity. The purpose of this is to ensure minimal overlap within our community, prevent any team from soliciting organizations already contributing to NDRA or other teams and to ensure that the proposed fundraising activity meets NDRA criteria.

Use of Funds

The following are the limits within which a team may raise money through fundraising. All revenue generated from the approved fundraising activity may be used to offset the cost of:

- NDRA apparel through our approved suppliers
- Approved Tournament registration fees
- Extra ice time
- Development clinics

Funds generated from fundraising activities will be utilized for the direct benefit of the players, as per the above list. Any inquiries concerning utilization of fundraising money should be directed to the Fundraising Chair. If there is no Fundraising Chair in a given year on the board, then the concerns should be directed to the President.

Conclusion of Activity

Upon the completion of each fundraising activity, the lead organizer for the activity shall be responsible for presenting a final analysis of the event to the team that ran the activity or the board, for an association event. The analysis shall detail the revenue generated and expenses incurred to run the activity.
