RULES AND REGULATIONS:

-Contestant will provide their own power wheels vehicle. This vehicle will be entered at the owners own risk into the derby. Any damage caused to the vehicle will NOT be the liability or responsibility of NSMHA or the New Sarepta Minor Hockey Association Demolition Derby. -NO aftermarket modifications to the structure of the power wheels unit. Painting is acceptable.

-Drivers must be between the ages of 4yrs and 7 yrs.

-Driver MUST wear a helmet which is to be provided by the owner/registrant of the vehicle.

TRACK RULES:

- Each vehicle will be fitted with 4 balloons taped onto the vehicle by one of NSMHA's flagmen. Balloons will be attached to each corner of the vehicle.
- The kids will then be placed in the track with their vehicle and they will attempt to pop their opponents balloons by bumping into them. The last vehicle with a balloon un-popped will win the heat.
