SANCTIONED ACTIVITIES

It's important to understand the difference between sanctioned and non-sanctioned activity:

- Sanctioned activities are officially approved by the NLSA and Canada Soccer. These events meet established safety standards, ensure proper insurance coverage, and require certified coaches and referees.
- Non-sanctioned activities fall outside of the Canada Soccer and NLSA ecosystem. They are not governed or sanctioned by either organization and are not covered by NLSA insurance.

NLSA supports clubs with administrative services and governance guidance such as:




- Discipline, appeals, and complaints processes
