## THE NORTH AMERICAN PREPARATORY HOCKEY ACADEMY (NAPHA) STRIVES TO INSTILL:

As a parent of a player representing North American Preparatory Hockey Academy, you are an integral part of ensuring the success of NAPHA.

As such, I agree to the following:

#### FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE STANDARDS MAY RESULT IN DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS; INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

1. A verbal warning regarding

the infraction.

2. A written warning regarding

the infraction.

3. Suspension or immediate

ejection from a game, practice

or team function for the

infraction.

4. Suspension from multiple

games, practices, or team

functions for the infraction.

5. Season suspension/expulsion

for the infraction.

The discipline action shall be at the discretion of the North American Preparatory Hockey Academy Executive Board or its Designee. The Board reserves the right to bypass any or all of the foregoing steps.

- 1. I will respect the game and learn and follow all rules of the game and regulations of PHL and NAPHA.
- 2. I will display control, respect, and professionalism to all involved with the sport. I will not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct with any opponents, coaches, officials, administrators, parents, players, spectators, the media, or other attendees. This includes verbal or physical threats, fights, profane language, or abuse aimed at any of the above-listed attendees.
- 3. In the event of a disagreement, I will not question, discuss or confront coaches at the rink and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed-upon time and place.
- 4. I will wait the prescribed 24 hours before approaching a coach with a game situation concern or any other issue or concern.
- 5. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practice unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
- 6. I understand my child may not play or participate in game practices of another ice hockey team during the 2022-23 season.

#### SOCIAL MEDIA

As a parent of a NAPHA player, I agree that I will not represent my views or opinions as those of NAPHA hockey in any forum, including social media. Social media includes, but is not limited to: Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, YouTube, group texts, etc.

### As such, I agree:

- 1. To protect confidential and proprietary NAPHA information.
- To be respectful in postings, this includes exercising good judgment before posting materials or statements about NAPHA or its opponents, which:
- a. Are or could be considered defamatory, vulgar, obscene, racially, culturally or ethnically offensive, harmful, harassing, inflammatory, intimidating, threatening, hateful, objectionable, discriminatory, or abusive;

- b. May violate any laws, rules, or regulations; or
- c. Could incite violence or hostility. This is especially important on public message boards or chat rooms where even a positive comment about NAPHA players, coaches, or the organization could be seen as inflammatory.
- 2. To not use any NAPHA logos, trademarks, or images in a negative manner on personal social media sites.
- 3. To not represent my personal views as those of NAPHA or its related organizations.
- 4. To not engage in cyber-bullying or other forms of harassment.

#### **USE OF IMAGE AND LIKENESS**

I understand that my image or likeness and/or the image or likeness of my child may appear in photographs, pictures, or other depictions related to NAPHA and that these materials may be used to promote the organization.
