Administrative Controls

1 designated Safety Ambassador wearing a high visibility vest per team to ensure COVID-19 Risk Mitigation Strategies are being met. Daily screening & tracing information available through Safety Ambassador.

One designated Safety Ambassador wearing a high visibility vest per team to ensure safety plans are being followed.

Occupancy Controls

1 parent permitted for U-9 and as approved by the Safety Ambassador per child. 65 people maximum for both games and practices. This includes: 20 players per team, 5 officials per team, 4 on-ice officials, and 2 off-ice officials. Up to 9 other personnel. No spectators are permitted at this time. Team cohorts permitted into 1 dressing room. 1 parent permitted for U-9
65 people maximum for both games and practices.
No spectators are permitted at this time.

Personal Protective Equipment

Disposable or Reusable face masks are mandatory except when on the field of play including: the ice surface, benches, and penalty boxes. Face masks are mandatory except when the player is on the field of play. Leave masks in a personal bag and physically distance as you walk from dressing room to the field of play.

Engineered Controls

Please enter & exit through the designated entrance:

Player's Entrance: Access to dressing rooms

Back rink-door: Access to the dressing rooms #4 & #5

Arrival time: 15 minutes before ice time starts.

Teams must leave rink 15 minutes after ice time ends.

Enter through the designated door and use the corresponding dressing room as communicated by Parks & Recreation.

Arrival time: 15 minutes before ice time starts, mostly dressed encouraged. Exit time: 15 minutes after ice time ends.
