Mini-Soccer:

Years of Birth 2021 & 2020

Teams are mixed gender and birth years, 9 players maximum to a team, 3 vs 3 format with no goalkeeper
All games will be in Oakbank and starting at 5:15pm, Monday. Activities are an hour long.

Fun, basic skills and basic physical literacy will be the emphasis

A team's schedule will be **one night per week**.

All players require shin guards, soccer cleats are optional. Team shirts and a ball are provided.

Season starts April 29 (weather permitting), ends June 24

This program will require each team to have a parent volunteer to be the team's contact for the season

Years of Birth 2019 & 2018

Teams are mixed gender and birth years, 9 players maximum to a team, 3 vs 3 format with no goalkeeper
All games will be in Oakbank and starting at 6:15pm, Monday, & Wednesday. Activities are an hour long.

Fun basic skills and basic physical literacy will be the emphasis.

A team's schedule will be **two nights per week**.

All players require shin guards, soccer cleats are optional. Team shirts and a ball are provided.

This program will require each team to have a parent volunteer to be the team's contact for the season

Please note; we do not fill requests to "play with" for these two entry programs. All activities are in Oakbank. Sports are a way for your children to meet other children, not to reinforce parents existing social circles. If your child is socially shy please reconsider if they're at an age where this will be suitable for them. This is a non-competitive exposure to an organised and fun activity.

Years of Birth 2016(U8) & 2017(U7)

Teams are gender specific; play is 5 vs 5 with a goalkeeper

All players wear shin guards and soccer cleats

Games are in Oakbank

Season starts April 30 (weather permitting), ends June 25.

*Registration numbers may require combining these two age groups but they will remain gender specific.

Game days consist of 25-30 minute skills training and explanation of the rules of soccer, followed by two 15 minute halves of playing. Emphasis is on fun while learning, exposure to all positions of play, fair play and the concepts of team play. No scores are kept.
