As per the message from the IGM regarding refunds - we will be providing more information on the amount and the process for the refunds once we receive final costs of the season from Hockey Alberta as well as the Leagues our teams play in and other sundry costs. We will continue to work diligently on the refunds and will provide this information as soon as it is available. Please be advised that OMHA & OOAA will handle refunds separately. We appreciate your understanding on this matter.
