Dear Recreation User Groups,

We want to thank you for your ongoing efforts and support of recreation services these past 20 months as we continue to navigate through Covid-19. Unfortunately Covid-19 is not entirely behind us and there is some information that we want to share with you and as an organization, we ask that you communicate this information with your players, coaches, parents, managers, opponents etc.

- 1) Beginning **November 15th**, as part of the provincial Restrictions Exemption Program (REP), **digital or printed QR code**proof of full vaccination (14 days since second dose) is required to enter spaces participating in the REP. The app used to scan the code does not store any personal information. Anyone 18 & over entering the Recreation Centre & Pason Centennial Arenas must also show **personal identification** (i.e. driver's license). Note, showing printed proof of a privately-paid negative PCR or rapid test within 72 hours of service (Health Canada approved tests only) or original documentation of medical exemption are also options.
- 2) Masks & physical distancing are mandatory in all indoor public spaces including Town facilities. A friendly reminder that everyone is encouraged to carry masks with them to ensure entry as Town facilities have a very limited supply. Please ensure that everyone entering the facilities brings and wears masks in accordance with the guidelines. In the near future masks will not be provided.
