OMHA SAFETY PROGRAM

PLAYER HEALTH AND WELLNESS

SAFETY COACH

- In place of a paid trainer
- First on site for all injuries
- First step to the Emergency Response Plan
- Responsibility to the player to make sure they are cleared to return



EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN

- Charge person- One in control directing personnel- Call person- the one to call 911
- All teams should have one person with the address of each rink you are playing at and the closest emergency venue.

EQUIPMENT


U9 teams must submit a \$300.00 deposit to Amanda Germain, treasurer@okotokshockey.com

You will receive your deposit back once ALL equipment is returned at the end of season.

Socks- U9 must provide their own OMHA approved socks, they can be purchased at Classic Source for Sports. These can be purchased individually or the cost worked into the team budget.

REQUIRED FORMS

Following forms are required for parents/ players/ coaches to fill out. You will keep these forms on you for the duration of the season and they will always be available to the coaches during practices and games.

Please make copies of the medical forms for the coaches bag. Make sure any allergies and/ or medical issues are identified for player safety in the dressing room and for any team meals.

TEAM BUDGETS

- As in the prior year, U7 and U9 teams are required to send OMHA their preliminary budgets to the Treasurer before October 31, 2024 (<u>treasurer@okotokshockey.com</u>)
- There is a sample budget format on the OMHA website but any format will work if the details are included
- A final budget is required to be submitted at the end of the season (again to <u>treasurer@okotokshockey.com</u>)

CASH CALLS

- OMHA suggests that the team cash call is not to exceed \$200 without a fundraising component in the budget
- It is only the cash call component of the funds that may be returned to parents at the end of the year. You can NOT return fundraising funds, sponsorship money, etc to parents. These need to be spent on the team (use for tournaments, apparel, dryland, exhibition games, power skating, etc) or can be donated.
- Any excess funds at the end of the year do not belong to the coaching staff. Decisions on what to do with the funds must be brought up with the parents and the parents have the right to ask for their portion of the refund (up to the cash call amount) to be refunded to them before any remaining funds are donated

TEAM FUNDRAISING

Teams are permitted to raise money for their teams through fundraising, Sponsorship and cash calls.

APPAREL GUIDELINES

Guidelines: These can be found on the website under the Managers tab

Sponsor identification can be anywhere and any size on apparel

No modifications can be made to the logo, any size is allowed

Logo is available in colour and Black and White. All approved vendors have the logo file.

NO TEAM SPECIFIC LOGOS- We understand that some teams have individual names, but the logos representing any team in OMHA will be the pre-approved OMHA designs.

TOURNAMENTS

All teams can attend a MAXIMUM of 3 tournaments, including their home tournament (if applicable) and there will be no sanctions granted after March 16th, 2025

Remind parents that they represent OMHA at the arenas and hotels and to act accordingly. Hotels have kicked out teams in the middle of the night due to parent behaviors, we do not want OMHA to experience that.

Email Lindsay with the required information (as per the Managers Handbook) to receive your travel permit. You cannot attend tournaments without a Hockey Alberta Travel Permit.
