2018-19 Flood Document

CAHL Games

Atom games must be 1.5 hours minimum in league play. Games are normally played on 1.5 hour spots sometimes 1.75 hours. They must go on clean ice and there are no floods. If by chance on a rare occasion they get a 2 hour slot then a flood will occur after 2 periods.

Peewee and Bantam games must be 2 hours minimum in league play. Games are normally played in 2 hour spots. They must go on clean ice and a flood occurs only after the 2nd period. If by chance on a rare occasion they get a 2.25 hour slot then before the game a decision can be made to add a flood. No matter what a flood still has to happen after the 2nd period.

Midget Games must be 2.25 hours minimum in league play. Games are played in both 2.25 hours and 2.5 hour spots. They must go on clean ice and a flood **must** occur every period.

RMFHL and RHL Games

Still as of this season there are no rules on length of games for any age. OMHA would like to see all RMFHL and RHL games start on fresh ice. If a game is 1.5 or 1.75 hours there are no floods. If a game is 2 hours long then a flood should occur after the second period. If a game is 2.25 hours long then before the game a decision can be made to add a flood. No matter what a flood still has to happen after the 2nd period.

When making a decision to add a flood, the discussion needs to be with the rink attendants, both managers, and then the referees should be informed before a game.

Okotoks House games

OMHA would like to see all House games start on fresh ice. No floods are needed in Either Atom or Novice House games.
