

FACILITY INFORMATION

Guidelines of Use for the Okotoks Arenas:

ICE/FLOOR USE: Users must get on the ice/floor at their designated time and leave the ice/floor when their time is up.

HELMET: No person shall engage in any form of ice activity in a Town owned or operated ice surface unless such person is wearing a CSA approved safety helmet.

DRESSING ROOMS: Teams must use the dressing rooms assigned to them. Dressing rooms are accessible ½ hour prior to your ice/floor time and must be vacated a ½ hour after your ice/floor time ends. Users are responsible for leaving their dressing rooms in a clean and acceptable manner. The Town of Okotoks will not be responsible for the loss or theft of any personal property.

FLOODS & ICE RESURFACER: A 15-minute time allotment is scheduled for all flood times. For your safety, please stay off the ice during this time. No participant is allowed on the ice while the ice resurfacer is in use. No one is allowed to enter the ice until the resurfacer is completely off the ice and the facility operator has closed the gates to the arena.

CONCESSION: The concession operator has first rights of refusal of all food services in The Okotoks Recreation Centre, Wylie Park Athletic Fields, and the Viking Rentals Centre as per the Recreation Centre Concession Agreement Section 3, Clause 3.8. Client must contact concession operator to make requests or arrangements.

PARKING: Overnight parking is not allowed at the Recreation Centre or Viking Rentals Centre unless preauthorized by the Recreation Facilities Manager.

AIRHORNS: The use of air horns is prohibited in our arenas.

VIKING RENTALS CENTRE GREEN CONCOURSE USAGE: The concourse (public open space area adjacent to the concession and running track at the VRC Green Arena is available for warm-up activities only to users with a current arena rental contract and can be used at no charge prior to their scheduled arena time. Additional equipment is prohibited (sports ladders, cones, hurdles, ball, weights, etc.)

MUSIC/SPEAKERS: Please refrain from playing music within centres out of respect for all users. Speakers should be kept in dressing rooms at a respectful level to all patrons.
