 - Jamie will be meeting the RMFHL mid June, they admitted to errors in previous years and are looking at resolving these issues in the upcoming season
- Kim Saunders wondering on who determines which teams get set practices vs rotating practices
 - Jamie said that teams that don't generally have practise outside of Okotoks or early mornings will get set practices (ie. House teams, female teams that don't travel for practise or have early morning); teams that practise in Stavely or early morning don't have set practices because it is not fair for 1 team to always have a practise in Stavely, etc.

Questions or Comments:

- Parent questioned if their female 2nd year BT player does not make Elite, how could they register for RHL? And historically, how many females played in RHL last year?
 - You would have the ability to change your registration from Female BT to RHL prior to the start of
 evaluations, and last year there was only 1 female that played in the Midget RHL league, none in Bantam
- Carolyn Berven questioned where female teams will play if they don't make Elite, could they go to RHL? Is there a
 plan, or back-up plan if they do not play RMFHL? Is RHL capable to take in female teams? Will it be done by
 registration?
 - Jamie Yes, there has been lots of discussion on this but it is hopeful and promising that RMFHL will be moving forward in a positive direction as they admitted there were mistakes made in the past; yes to RHL capability
 - o Final team placement (RMFHL vs RHL) may not be done when registration starts, but will be presented by the time registration closes
 - o Dan LaPlante wanted parents who had no players in female to understand the female placement issues



- Jamie notified the membership that RMFHL has a VP position open and recommended someone from Okotoks look at the position; would strengthen the voice Okotoks had in RMFHL
- Parent question was their daughter's 1st year playing in Okotoks, played Atom female team in CAHL, loved playing with an all-girls team; would there be a possibility to have Okotoks create a female program?
 - Parent comment Hockey Calgary did it, why can't we?
 - We do not have the numbers
- Kurt Thomas plan for novice next year
 - HA didn't change much; there will be no travel team for Novice this year and instead all teams will be playing
 in an OMHA house program, possible divisions of A, B, C; talking with Airdrie and Cochrane to align teams to
 play; would include female teams
 - Parent comment to suggest talking to Indus too
- Kim Saunders Evaluation scheduling question is there a way to have the OMHA evaluations start after OOAA evaluations? Last year her daughter was only able to make the coach skates
 - Unfortunately that is not possible as it is already pushed back as far as it can go; OMHA is forced to start
 because certain leagues need rosters by a certain date; OMHA waits as long as we can; next year it will be
 mandatory for all players to attend OMHA evaluations even if they are still in the OOAA tryouts; will try to
 schedule times to avoid conflicts with OOAA evals but can't be guaranteed
- Note from Jamie: CAHL is having an M15 league for midget players next year; details to be announced later
- Parent question is there a way for all kids to have similar number of skates in prior to evals?
 - That is hard, OMHA offers the same number of evaluation/skills skates but some kids pay to try out for AAA, AA, M15 so they will have more skates in than someone who is only doing the OMHA skates
- Note from Geoff: Players who try out for SHL will be allowed back into OMHA, however, HA/HC may not allow OMHA
 to card these players and HA sanctioned events may disqualify your player from playing in those events
