this is ever changing. As of right now anyone who was an official last year does not expire now until Jan 31, 2021 (normal expiry would be December 1)

- Anyone who is using officials for games needs to make sure Rink Staff is aware. SSSA is not allowing
 officials at the moment so we will not be officiating in that arena. All games that were currently
 scheduled there have had to be moved to town arena
- OMHA & ORA is a test centre for officials. At this point no other centres are using officials currently (this includes Calgary, Airdrie etc.) Once we hammer out the model it will be deployed to other centres
- If you are booking officials for any type of games please clear with Jamie / Gabe prior to sending to ORA for assigning
- We will not be assigning officials at this point for Novice / Atom / Pewee and are only looking to staff
 officials at higher A program Hockey as it currently sits we will not have enough officials in Okotoks
 or the Region to staff lower levels with a 14 day isolation period. We have been sending officials
 already for COVID tests in order for them to work a different cohort bypassing the 14 day isolation
 period.
- Jamie & Gabe have been getting info that has been passed down to us with respects to HA & Central region and directives coming out of those bodies. However everything is aligned
- There is a new assignor however, not sure how everything is looking yet. Brenda is still the assigning director so questions regarding assigning for the time being can be sent her way
- Team Charges(\$125 per team) have changed temporarily for COVID and we will send a separate note to Amanda & Jamie regarding this
- As of right now we have managed to fill 27 games with officials managing it through Cohorts and 14 day isolations and or COVID tests. To date only had to send two officials for COVID testing so we could fill slots
- Check in requirements with OMHA have been going well, will need to fine tune a few things but so far so good
