- Has Hockey AB set a standard for Novice tournaments? Fees are way too high/not split squad/double \$

- Lots of questions asking about Peewee House

- Lots of questions asking about Bantam in CAHL
 - If there is enough interest to keep a tier 4 in CAHL as a non-contact team, then we will do what our membership wants; however, the bottom 2 teams historically have low turnout for practices, especially those in Stavely and early mornings; these bottom 2 teams also have lower commitment levels from players; it is recommended to take all of the above into account prior to signing up for Bantam Travel

- Lots of questions about COVID-19 and it's affects on the season.
 - o Hockey Canada has allowed sanctioned events, and Hockey Alberta is creating their Return to Play

- Miscellaneous Notes
 - Fee increase could not be helped as our budget was bare bones and many items that make up our typical year were cut; Player's fees are primarily the costs for ice, referees, and fees to HA/Leagues so if they up their rates then we have no choice but to follow
