- RMFHL Changes
 - o RMFHL Executive has decided that all teams will make the playoffs this year. A point percentage will be used in situations where teams haven't played even amount of games due to one reason or another. Standings are simply going to determine the ranking position for playoffs.
 - Should one of your teams encounter a situation in which they will not be able to ice a healthy roster for a game, we are asking that they immediately notify the opposing team as well as the league. Our first preference is that the teams try to reschedule the game. If, after a week's time from the notice of postponement, the two teams are unable to find any ice to play the game, the league must be notified and a decision will be made on whether to cancel the game outright.
 - We will not be extending the regular season or playoff dates as we need to stay on course with the dates set for Provincials.
