- 2. ORA to Roll into OMHA
 - Directive from Hockey Alberta for the minor hockey associations to pay officials directly and that the referees associations no longer have bank accounts. Everything to be going through the minor hockey associations.
 - Working with Todd / Kelly / Geoff to build a working group to determine the feasibility of this, as well as building out costs associated to go back to Hockey Alberta with the proposal on what this will take
- 3. Clinics
 - There is issues with the new Hockey Canada (HCR 3) system, and is causing a delay in clinics.
- Officials Rooms
 - Reminder the officials rooms are prioritized for officials. If coaches / instructors / evaluators
 are using the rooms, please make sure that you leave enough room for the officials to get
 ready, and please do not sit in the room after your ice time to discuss your players, cuts, or
 evaluations. As well as the officials room is not for team staff to simply use the
 washroom. There have been multiple issues already with people just walking in and using
 the washroom, or using it as their office.

- Cancellation of the tournament / change in # of games <15 days notice will incur a \$6 per game cancellation/change fee (ex. 10 games cancelled/changed/added = \$60 fee)
