- A reminder to respect your scheduled ice times. Understanding the arena staff places a variety of different pressures on us to exit the ice, we owe it to each other in keeping to our scheduled times. Activities must end on time and teams need to be off the ice at the scheduled end time. This includes all training equipment, rink boards etc. Delays end up affecting subsequent ice slots. In some cases visiting teams have travelled multiple hours to attend games. Having a team get on the ice late and then have to shorten thier games to get back on schedule is frustrating and reflects poorly on our association. It was suggested that we review weekend start times to allow extra time for set-up and removal of equipment for our U7 and U9 groups to ensure they can enjoy a full ice slot. We will inquire on cost and availability with the arena to front load 10-15min on weekends. Any change would come into effect during the 2023-24 season.
- I have received positive feedback from our membership regarding social media postings highlighting team success through the season. Be it Tournament results, Community involvement or other interesting stuff. The kids love seeing their teams and themselves online so I encourage everyone to keep submitting your stories and pictures
