- Goalie gear for all levels: This is something we have never done before so there is limited gear available, especially for older age groups. Do we want to be looking to "stock" gear of various sizes to be able to outfit a goalie at any age group? Could look at purchasing gear second hand for this purpose. People are asking for goalie cups, pants and helmets. These three things have never been supplied by OMHA, I would suggest maybe we do goalie cups for next seasons, pants for the following season. We could ignore the helmets if we can find a supplier of danglers for standard player helmets to add into each bag.
- Old Jerseys: Significant number of old jerseys. Will update tryout jerseys and start to donate jerseys that are not needed.
- Start a hard count inventory to better manage the equipment and such for the future seasons and clear some space out.
- Tryout jerseys: Reminder to put the jerseys back where you picked them up.
- Boards: Will make instructions for the boards and put them with the boards/ helmets. Minimum 4 people for putting up and taking down the boards and no players on the ice.
