President – Jennifer Dustow

Kari has put in a tremendous amount of work over the years creating parameters and policies on social media as well as the website.

2. **Spring & Summer 2026 Development Sessions**

- Spring Ice Schedule has been finalized, and we plan to have it posted this week.
- Email will be shared with OAAA players/families directly from CW Development. This will allow families to reach out to Tyler or Colin directly to answer any questions they may have.
- Early bird registration extended to end of February.
- Registration will be shared with draw zone associations and OMHA to share with Tier 1 teams end of January.
- **Spring Session:** April 20 – June 11, 2026 (16 skills sessions + 4 three-on-three games).
- **Summer Session:** June 29 – August 6, 2026 (12 skills sessions + 4 three-on-three games).
- Schedule Overview:
 - Mon/Wed: U13 & U15 Female – Evening
 - Tue/Thu: U17/U18 Male & U18 Female – Daytime (aligned with current AAA schedule)
 - Tue/Thu: U13 & U15 Male – Evening
- Partnerships: K & M Hockey, Dallas Robbins.

1. **Spring Evaluations – 2026 Season**

- Ice secured for all divisions – Preliminary Schedule will be posted in early February with registration opening end of February/Early March.

To recap the Spring Evaluations will look like this:

- Combined camps: U18/U17AAA
- Individual camps: U15AAA, U15AA, U13AAA, U13AA, U15AA, U18AA, U18AAA Female.

- Structure:
 - Spring open camps → Fall invitation-only main camps for some divisions.
 - Invitations signal coach interest and encourage player development over the summer.
 -
 - Open fall camps for the following divisions: U13AA Raiders, U15AA Raiders, U18AA Raiders, U16AA Oilers, U18AA Oilers.
 - Fee structure is being determined
 - Implement Skill Shark for our coaches to utilize for evaluations and in season. Mark has piloted skill shark this fall and is currently using it for his team. Results have been positive, and a recommendation has been made to utilize this as an association. Cost will be built into registration fee's and is approximately 20/player. I will let Mark talk about this more when we get to him.
2. **Raiders Takeover in Strathmore.** Social media campaign to promote this event will start this week. We look forward to showcasing our program in this draw zone.
- Teams will not only be representing the Raiders program in Strathmore but they will also be wearing a helmet sticker to show their support for Livy Krall, a 9 year old ringette player from the Wheatland area who has been diagnosed with a rare and severe neurological condition that arises after a viral infection. Livy has been receiving treatment in Children's Hospital since December 6th. Helmet stickers are being supplied for the 3 – AA teams by the Wheatland Wranglers organization. The stickers are a part of a fundraising effort to support the family. 100% of the proceeds will go directly to the Krall family to help them be with their daughter during this time.
 - The U13AAA Strathmore team has offered to share their camera equipment and encoder with our teams to livestream the game. Grant has been working to help coordinate this and we are extremely grateful to the team for offering us this.
