Schedule for Evaluations:

- 1. Spring evaluation in April. Players must attend Spring evaluations to be eligible for commitment With the exception of U18AAA Raiders.
 - a. Player Commitments
 - i. Goal of getting all commitments by the end of April
 - ii. Player Agreement presented with 48hour review and commit period
 - iii. \$3,000 Deposit for AAA teams (excluding U13AAA)
 - iv. \$1,500 Deposit for AA teams and U13AAA
 - v. Deposits are equivalent to 50% of the first cash call and are transferred to teams after team formation
- 2. Player invitations to main camp issued no later than June 1st
- 3. List of committed players and main camp invitees published by August 1
- 4. Conditioning Camps starting mid August
- 5. Last Tryout (1-2 Ice Sessions) first with invitation to AAA main camp
- 6. Main AAA Camps in late August and early Sept
- 7. AA Tryouts following AAA Main Camps
