- Met with coaches and division directors to review the 2024/2025 evaluation process and come up with a plan for the 2025/2026 spring and fall evaluations. There was a lot of great conversations and input shared. Looking forward to building a plan for the 2026 Spring evaluations.
- OOAA will be running a spring/summer development sessions.
- Work with Jamie Steer to schedule in the Spring and Summer programs.

Apparel & Sponsorship

- Apparel Lookbook finalized with clear ordering and logo guidelines. This has been shared out to all teams and will be communicated at the managers meeting. We finally have this streamlined so the process is straightforward for teams. Thanks to everyone for your input and support on that. Lululemon and Classic Source for Sports being utilized for team apparel this season.
- Team sponsorship policy completed—helping teams offset apparel costs. There is a guide that will be shared with all teams and at the managers meeting. This policy clearly outlines levels of sponsorship, and logo placement expectations. This is just the start as we are looking to expand this into jersey sponsorship opportunities for the 2026-2027 season. A committee of Tamara Spencer, Nicole Brockhoff, and Melissa Deplate will be compiling information on other Elite associations and what kind of jersey sponsorship programs they offer so we can come up with some guidelines for our association. I will be discussing with Dan and Diane as well to understand what will work best for our jerseys and the life span of the current sets.

- Plan in place to reinventory and prepare for Spring Evaluations

Academics & Accountability

Skill Shark will be discussed as an evaluation tool – parameters set up, players names listed, key point of evaluation, notes area. We will continue it all season. The players profile will follow them year after year. There is an area for players to enter in their feedback on the game as well so the coaches can see where the player is at.

Everything are ranked 1-5, these scores will be shared with the parents so they know exactly what the coaches are seeing.

The cost is \$18 a player.

Bouka the trainer has parameters set and so do the academic support teachers.

More data on each player.

Skill Shark will integrate all Coaches scores so the final score will be level set and come up with a score for them. Lots of room for feedback. Gives parents a big breakdown of what the coaches see.

Bowmark will trail it and we will get feedback from the parents. If it is positive we will role it out to all teams next year.

Mark was at the gym. The U18AAA Raiders did some testing.

AJ at Training Foundation spoke to Bowmark/ U17AAA about being professional. Acting the right way, being prepared and having the correct equipment.

VP- Jay Brockhoff- can we look into making hockey as affordable as possible with more sponsorship. We need Jersey sponsors, with corporate sponsors. YES a committee is in place and will be looking at sponsorship for all teams and all items. Helmet stickers etc

There will be a cap in OMHA next season. They will be looking into this deeper prior to the start of next season.
