# What are the OMHA and OOAA Fees For?

Here is a breakdown to help you understand why these fees are collected, how they are collected from teams, and how the money is used by the association.

## **Fee Structure**

Every OOAA player pays the following fees:

OMHA Fee: \$210OOAA Fee: \$200

These fees apply regardless of whether the player is on a AAA (Fee's are invoiced directly to the team and paid to OOAA and OMHA from the team bank account) or AA team (Fee's are deducted from the player OMHA registration fee's before being transferred to the teams bank account).

## **OMHA Fees**

Okotoks Minor Hockey is the governing body of OOAA. All Hockey Alberta invoices for OOAA players are sent to OMHA. OMHA pays for these expenses using these fees. OMHA covers the cost of:

- Insurance
- Rostering players
- RAMP fees
- OMHA Administration fees

## **OOAA Fees**

OOAA fees contribute to the operations of the association. The amount collected from all teams is approximately \$43,000. This is an extremely small percentage of the operating costs of the association.

The remaining operating costs are paid for from:

- Camp fees
- Tryout fees
- Casino fees

# What Type of Operating Expenses Does OOAA Have?

Below is a list of some of the expenses to run OOAA:

#### **Teams**

- Game Jerseys, patches for jerseys, logos and numbers, cresting
- Pucks
- Camera equipment
- Camera cart set up Monitor, keyboard, encoder, and all necessary cords
- iPads / Chromebooks for live scoring
- Mental health sessions
- Skills sessions (player and goalie)
- Monthly internet that is required to live stream games

### Prepaid Team Expenses - These are covered by the association until teams are formed

- Tournaments
- Bussing
- Flights
- Apparel
- Team equipment: gloves, helmets, pant shells, bags, socks
- Referee association requires a deposit for the entire season to be paid in early September
- Coach September honorariums
- League Fees
- Referee Association assigning fees

#### **Coaches**

- Coach apparel up to \$1,000 per team
- Coach Clinics these prices range from a few hundred dollars to a couple thousand dollars for HP1
- Coach Honorariums for March, April and August (team dependent)
- Monthly fuel allowance for out-of-town coaches

## **Tryouts and Camps**

- Ice
- Cost for on-ice instructors
- Athletic Therapists
- Referees
- Tryout Jerseys
- Pre-Season Tournaments
- Room Rentals for parent information sessions, player interviews
- Director expenses related to tryouts or camps, program printing, etc

# **Operations**

- Contractor Salaries Coach Director, Ice Scheduler, Administrator
- Insurance and utilities for the storage facility
- Room rentals for meetings
- OOAA Annual Awards Banquet for Athletes and Coaches
- Storage facility rental fee
- Misc office supplies, photocopies etc
- Coach Them program
- Forensic annual audit
- Accounting fees
