Transportation

(i) All team activities that take place at a venue that exceeds One Hundred Seventy Five (175) kilometers in distance each way, from the team's home arena, will require the team to take a bus. All team members – coaches, manager and all Players are required to travel on the bus unless otherwise authorized by the Head Coach to travel with their Parents;

(ii) Out of town tournaments / events require approval by the OAAA division director which will be granted once a plan is submitted to safely move players to and from the tournament / event.

(iii) Alcohol, Non-Prescription Drugs or Tobacco / Vaping paraphernalia is never permitted on a team bus or event for any reason;

(iv) Parents may be allowed to travel on the bus to the extent that room is available. In the event of limited seating, one member from each Player's family will have the first option on seating and if additional seating remains available, the seats will be made available to other family members on a first come basis

Coaches can declare a trip a "Team only trip" where only Players and Team Management are allowed to travel on the bus; and

(vi) No Player shall drive to an away game. Parents unable to attend must arrange transportation with a Parent of another Team Player or Team Management. Failing to do so, the Parent must notify the Team Manager to make transportation arrangements.

Proposed

All team activities that take place at a venue that exceeds One Hundred Seventy Five (175) kilometers in distance each way, **from Centennial Arena**, will require the team to take a bus. All team members – coaches, manager and all Players are required to travel on the bus unless otherwise authorized by the Head Coach to travel with their Parents.

Parents may be allowed to travel on the bus to the extent that room is available. In the event of limited seating, one member from each Player's family will have the first option on seating and if additional seating remains available, the seats will be made available to other family members on a first come basis.

Coaches can declare a trip a "Team only trip" where only Players and Team Management are allowed to travel on the bus.

Alcohol, Non-Prescription Drugs or Tobacco / Vaping paraphernalia is never permitted on a team bus or event for any reason.

Teams must include the transportation safety director on their teamsnap, as well provide a list of all away games and a live google spread sheet with persons riding the bus. This will include players, team staff and parents names, dates of birth, emergency contact information, known

medical issues and medications. Team staff is encouraged to keep a copy of this list on their person during trips. Teams must also list Transportation Safety Director as the emergency contact with all bussing companies.

Tournaments

All teams travelling to tournaments outside the 175 km range must take a bus to the tournament. Teams may choose to fly to away tournaments but must also provide ground transportation for the team. Teams must submit flight information to transportation safety director when flying.

Exceptions will be made for all SCAHL teams travelling to their playoff tournaments. Teams will be required to bus to the tournament but are able to release the bus anytime after the first game.

Teams travelling for a best of 3 series, where all 3 games are hosted by one team, must use the bus for the first 2 games, with the 3rd game being exempt from bussing.

Bad weather driving

In the event of bad weather – if your bus will not travel, please contact your league governor, opposing team manager and Transportation Safety director to cancel the game. In the event of parent driven games, please consult road reports and call local bus companies to see if they would drive. Consult your league governor, opposing team manager and transportation safety director with all the information for cancelling a game.

Players Driving

No Player shall drive to an away game. Parents unable to attend must arrange transportation with a Parent of another Team Player or Team Management. Failing to do so, the Parent must notify the Team Manager to make transportation arrangements. Players may not drive from hotels to rinks when at tournaments that are parent driven.

Parents wanting their child to drive to select locations may sign a waiver allowing their player to do so and removes all responsibilities from the team staff.
