 - AEHL Schedule of 32 games

Team Budgets

Each team's budget will depend on various factors:

- # of Tournaments and tournament travel
- League travel (northern AB)
- Ice times/Referees
- Coach Honorariums
- Hudl Assist and Video Review Sessions for U16AA
- Sponsorship and Fundraising can be used to offset team expenses

U18AA cash calls have ranged from \$5,000 - \$6,000 per player U16AA cash calls have ranged from \$5,000-\$7,000 per player

- OOAA has a First Cash Call Policy min of \$3,000 per AA player to be paid by October 15th
- Committed players will pay \$1,500 for the remainder of their first cash call by October 15th
 - Second Cash call depends on team budget. Collected by November 15th
 - Third cash call dependent on team budget. Collected by December 15th





Athletic Therapist

- Each Team is assigned one AT with a back-up for the season
- Help players with preparation, injury prevention, injury treatment and assessment
- Reporting and follow-up on injury recovery
