## IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR OUT OF PROVINCE PLAYERS

## IMMEDIATE ACTION MAY BE REQUIRED

**IMPORTANT**: Players coming from another province or country are considered imports. Player transfers and approvals are required for any players who are <u>moving into Ontario or residing outside Ontario</u>. There are specific eligibility requirements and registration procedures. Please ensure approval from the OWHA registrar prior to permitting participation in any activities including try-outs.

In addition to the registration materials contained in this package, there are forms for:

- > International Transfers
- ➤ Inter-branch Transfers (within Canada)
- USA Transfers
- 1) If a player did not play within the Ontario Women's Hockey Association last season and has participated in hockey in another province or country, she may require approval, a release and a transfer. In many cases, this is required before the player is involved in any activity with a team.
- 2) If a player lives in another province or country and/or played ice hockey in another province or country she may require approval, a release and/or a transfer on an annual basis. In many cases, this is required before the player is involved in any activity with a team.

Please contact the OWHA Office immediately (before the player first steps onto the ice) if you have any players that may require one of these transfers. **IMPORTANT:** If either #1) or #2) apply to a potential player she may NOT participate in any hockey related activities until she has been cleared through the OWHA office.

This is very important.
