 - Last years Jr Rally coordinator was Karla Brassard, she will continue. Chris Dallyn was Sr Rally coordinator and this year Karla Brassard will take that on as well. Chris Dallyn will be 11U coordinator this year. Curtis Stasiw was the 13U coordinator last year and Curtis Bradbury will be this year. Nathan Noble is no longer the 15U coordinator and Matt Gray will be. The 18U coordinator was, and will continue to be, Troy Semenchuk.

- Discussion

- Looking to book to the Dave Steuart Arena for indoor camps and winter sessions.
