Recognize and applaud the ability and achievements of EVERY participant.

Accept winning and losing with graciousness - honest effort is as important as victory.

Consider the hard job the OFFICIALS have and treat them with RESPECT.

Recognize that every member of the PRA is a VOLUNTEER. Help and encourage all volunteers whenever possible to allow them to work to the best of their ability.

Respect all PLAYERS, COACHES, OPPONENTS, GAME OFFICIALS and SPECTATORS.

Do not embarrass your child by yelling at PLAYERS, COACHES, GAME OFFICIALS or SPECTATORS. Your child will benefit when you show a positive attitude towards the game and ALL of its participants.

PRA will enforce a zero tolerance policy towards situations of harassment or abuse directed against GAME OFFICIALS, PLAYERS, COACHES or SPECTATORS.
