# **Registration Information**

### Basketball Registration for the 2019-20 Season

Registration for the 2019-20 fall/winter season is now open!!! Stay informed and up to date through our website, Facebook, and Instagram pages. Thank you for interest in Parkland Basketball.

\*New\* There will be a \$17 fee added to your registration. We pay this fee direct to Alberta Basketball.

#### Wait List

PCBL House League teams and programs are on a first come first serve basis. If a team is full when a player registers for our house league program, players will be placed on a waiting list. Players registered for EYBA / Parkland Pride teams are formed and allocated through an evaluation / tryout process. Any players not selected for an EYBA / Pride team is automatically placed on one of our house league teams and refunded the difference in program fees.

### Late registration

House League - Any registrations received after 12:00pm (noon) on September 15th, 2019 will be considered a late registration for our house league and will be subject to a **\$50 Late Registration Fee**.

EYBA / Pride - Registration cut off is 12:00 pm (noon) September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Any registration after this will be subject to the same **\$50.00 late registration Fee. Please note: Must be registered prior to evaluation dates for this program. Dates TBD** 

### **Age Categories & Fees**

**Initiation - JR NBA Program** - Players born in 2011 & 2014 belong in this category. Players looking for a year of more focused instruction and a less competitive environment). This program is designed to focus strongly on developing skills at the most basic level and ease the transition to competitive play. A smaller, lighter ball will be used at this level as many players are still developing confidence in their passing and catching skills and most still struggle with their ability to get the ball to the height of the basket while under pressure. We generally recommend this level to those participating in basketball for the first time.

Fee: \$110.00 (Registration) + \$17 (Alberta Basketball Membership)

#### PCBL HOUSE LEAGUE

<u>U9 HOUSE (MITES)</u> - Under 9 - Players born in 2011 - 2012 belong in this category. The Mites program is a mixed (boys and girls) category. Mites meet for a 75 min. skill development session, once a week in Parkland County and are involved in a year end tournament . Parkland follows the Steve Nash Youth Basketball program. Players will participate in practices and small games which focus on skill development while keeping it fun for the kids. The athletes will play various modified games: 3 on 3 half court, 4 on4 half court, and will transition during the season into 4 on 4 full court games.

Fee: \$250 (Registration) + \$17 (Alberta Basketball Membership)

**<u>U11 HOUSE (MINI'S)</u>** - **Players born in 2009 - 2010** belong in this category. (2012 will be considered if completed jr. NBA Initiation). The U11s play once a week (Saturday and/or some Sundays) and practice once a week in a gym in Parkland County. The rules have been adapted for these young athletes. The athletes will play various modified games: 3 on 3 half court, 4 on 4 half court, and will transition during the season into 4 on 4 full court games.

Fee: \$250 (Registration) + \$17 (Alberta Basketball Membership) = \$267.00

**<u>U13 HOUSE (BANTAM)</u>** - Players born in 2007 - 2008 belong in this category. The U13s play once a week (Saturday and/or some Sundays) and practice once a week in a gym in Parkland County. Games are played five on five, and they play four eight minute quarters.

Fee: \$250 (Registration) + \$17 (Alberta Basketball Membership) = \$267.00

**<u>U15 HOUSE (MIDGET)</u>** - Players born in 2005 - 2006 belong in this category. The U15s play once a week (Saturday and/or some Sundays) and practice once a week in a gym in Parkland County. Games are played five on five, and they play four nine minute quarters.

Fee: \$250 (Registration) + \$17 (Alberta Basketball Membership)=\$267.00

**U18 HOUSE (JUVENILE)** - Players born in 2002 - 2004 belong in this category. The U18s play once sometimes twice a week (Saturday and/or some Sunday) and practice once a week in a gym in Parkland County. There are two separate seasons for the U18 age category. The first season is the Fall League, which runs from September to November. The second season is the Winter League in the EYBA, which runs from January to March.

Please note players participating on any high school basketball team (Sr. levels), are not eligible to play in the Winter League due to Alberta Schools Athletic Association rules that states "To be eligible for high school provincial competition in the ASAA sports of basketball, volleyball, football, cheerleading, team handball and rugby, a high school student is not permitted to play on a non-school team in the same sport during the same season."

Fee: \$170.00 (Registration) + \$17 (Alberta Basketball Membership) = \$187.00

#### EYBA / Parkland Pride Competitive

**U11 Pride**- Players born in 2009 - 2010 belong in this category. **NOTE THIS DIVISION WILL BE SUBJECT TO REGISTRATION NUMBERS AND SKILL LEVEL OF THE GROUP AS A WHOLE.** If we are unable to form a team for the 2019/20 season players registered for this program will be placed in our house league and refunded the difference. The U11s play once a week, (Saturday and/or some Sundays in Edmonton and surrounding area.), and practice once a week in a gym in Parkland County. The rules have been adapted for these young athletes. The athletes will play 4 on 4 with modified quarter lengths.

Fee: \$350 (Registration) + \$17 (Alberta Basketball Membership) = \$367.00

**U13 PRIDE** - Players born in 2007 - 2008 belong in this category. The U13s play once a week (Saturday and/or some Sundays in Edmonton and surrounding area. ) and practice once a week in a gym in Parkland County. Games are played five on five, and they play four eight minute quarters.

Fee: \$380 (Registration) + \$17 (Alberta Basketball Membership) = \$397.00

**U15 PRIDE** - Players born in 2005 - 2006 belong in this category. The U15s play once a week (Saturday and/or some Sundays in Edmonton and surrounding area. ) and practice once a week in a gym in Parkland County. Games are played five on five, and they play four nine minute quarters.

Fee: \$380 (Registration) + \$17 (Alberta Basketball Membership)=\$397.00

**U18 PRIDE**- Players born in 2002 - 2004 belong in this category. The U17s play once sometimes twice a week (Saturday and/or some Sunday in Edmonton and surrounding area. ) and practice once a week in a gym in Parkland County. There are two separate seasons for the U17 age category. The first season is the Fall League, which runs from September to November. The second season is the Winter League in the EYBA, which runs from January to March.

Please note players participating on any high school basketball team (Jr or Sr. levels), are not eligible to play in the Winter League due to Alberta Schools Athletic Association rules that states "To be eligible for

high school provincial competition in the ASAA sports of basketball, volleyball, football, cheerleading, team handball and rugby, a high school student is not permitted to play on a non-school team in the same sport during the same season."

Fee: \$250.00 (Registration) + \$17 (Alberta Basketball Membership) = \$267.00

## **General Information**

**EYBA / Pride** - The season begins mid-September with evaluation sessions at U13, U15, and U18 levels (See A/B Division below). These evaluation sessions will take place in **Late August, Early September** group players of like ability onto teams to compete against similar strength teams from other communities in the City Teams. In March teams will compete in EYBA playoffs which are used to determine the top teams, which will be eligible to compete in the Provincial tournament.

**HOUSE LEAGUE** – U9 through to U15 teams will compete in a developmental and fun-oriented Parkland League from October through February. The month of March is filled with wind up tournaments for each respective division.

**Equipment** - All players require clean, indoor athletic shoes and a properly sized basketball. Jerseys will be supplied to teams in Mini, Bantam, Midget and Juvenile.

#### Ball Size -

Size 5 (27 1/2") - Juniors Co-Ed, U11 Boys and Girls Size 6 (28 1/2") - U13 Boys and Girls, U15 Girls, U17 Girls Size 7 (29 1/2") - U15 Boys, U17 Boys

<u>Practice</u> - We will not know your specific gym times; you should be prepared to practice between 6:00 pm and 10:00 pm from Monday to Friday. We will do our best to accommodate all players, but our first commitment is to the coach's schedule. We typically schedule younger age groups during the earlier time slots and the older players utilize the later spots.

**A/B Division (U13, U15 and U18)** - If an A/B team is entered in EYBA, the committee will then select the top 10-12 players from the evaluations in August / September. Exact dates, times & locations for "Pride" tryouts will be posted on the Parkland website by late August/early Sept. A/B /C team players will play in the EYBA. Typically, Boys "A and B" division games are scheduled for Tuesday evenings and Girls "A and B" divisions on Wednesday evenings. Pride U18 games are on Friday , Saturdays and Odd Sundays. C divisions and lower play on the weekends. Saturdays and Odd Sundays.
