Meeting called to order at 7:01 pm with quorum.

Motion to adopt agenda for July 14, 2021. Chris/Chantell. Motion carried.

## Reports:

- 1. President:
  - a. GELC/ALA report
    - i. 16U summer A team travel to Sask. weekend only
    - ii. Proposal Senior/Junior Miners involved in A Level coaching. Suggested B level help.
    - iii. GELC sent membership fee and coach training invoices.
    - iv. ALA Bylaws GELC voted unanimously to ask that no bylaw changes be made until the Board is re-elected and a permanent Exec. Assistant is hired
    - v. 4vs4 league out of Beaumont: October-January, co-ed teams. GELC to send out more info. Possibility for games to be held in other locations.
    - vi. Proposals for format change for September meeting: parity plus/ development & competitive stream/ keep zones/ CL-LTDP no competitive stream until after 12U/ coach requirements. After discussion, we prefer development & competitive stream

### 2. Treasurer:

- a. Reports were sent out ahead of time.
- b. Clear communication re Minor vs Junior
  - i. Finances: Projected Junior approx. \$7000 in the bank after 2021 operate at a loss for this season as there was approx. \$9400 remaining from 2020
  - ii. Minor projecting approx. \$25,000 surplus for 2021 but most of that is due to the Grant we received.

### **New Business:**

Future of Junior under the Minor banner

- 1. Run 2 teams or Tier 1 only risk to Tier II viability if ALA creates a U17/18 league
- 2. Expansion or buy an existing franchise
  - a. Tier 1 budget is approx. \$40,000
  - b. Do we want to keep Junior under the Posse Banner or do we want to sell the Junior bond to a private entity
    - iii. Pros: continuity, shared costs and volunteer support, grow the club
    - iv. Cons: disconnect, financial risk to Minor club, private entity has no guarantee to stay local
  - c. Do we structure the Society in order to separate the risk to Minor from Junior?

ACTION ITEM: Chantell will contact someone regarding setting up the society so that the Minor and Junior are separate entities and neither is responsible for the financial risk of the other

## **Old Business:**

Winter Programming:

- 1. Development camps
  - a. Support GELC winter programs
  - b. Come try it events
    - i. small fee to cover cost
    - ii. can lose interest if nothing offered soon after
    - iii. concentrate them a few weeks before registration starting in January
    - iv. take the "try it" to the students in the schools

MOTION: We will support and advertise for the GELC Winter 4 on 4 league and we will begin our own programming in January at the conclusion of the 4 on 4 league up until our A tryouts. Ray/Chris. MOTION CARRIED

- 2. 4V4 tournament
  - a. partner with CanLax but Posse would have to apply to host as the sanctioned entity
  - b. Requires Posse volunteers to operate, including a tournament committee
  - c. Tentatively booked for Nov 13 & 14 at the TLC
  - d. Register as a Team not as individual player
  - e. Ask GELC to support the tournament and not hold Winter programs that weekend

MOTION: Posse will apply to sanction a tournament on Nov 13-14 in partnership with CanLax and form a sub-committee to support the tournament planning. Chris/Matt. MOTION CARRIED
