

# Portugal Cove-St. Philips Minor Soccer Association

## Team Fundraising-Sponsorship Policy April 5, 2024

#### **PREAMBLE**

Portugal Cove - St. Philips Minor Soccer Association (PCSPMSA) has a responsibility to our members, athletes, coaches, and the community to ensure that any funds raised is spent in a manner consistent with the purpose for which it was raised.

#### **APPROVAL**

- a) To be eligible for fundraising, a team must send a proposal for the fundraising outlining the purpose and manner of fundraising to the office of PCSPMSA for approval.
- b) A budget outlining anticipated revenue and expenses for the money to be raised must accompany all applications for fundraising.
- c) All fundraising undertaken by teams, team members or coaches with the Association must receive approval from the club office prior to proceeding.
- d) Upon approval, all funds raised must be submitted to the Treasurer for accounting purposes and disbursement.

### **GUIDELINES**

- a) No minor team, as governed by the NLSA Constitution, shall be sponsored by a brewery/distillery and/or tobacco company.
- b) All sponsorship cheques are to be made payable to the Portugal Cove St. Philips Minor Soccer Association.
- c) The team Manager or team designated Fundraising coordinator must provide all players (parents where minor) with up-to-date accounting of their fundraising efforts to ensure transparency.
- d) All monies remaining in a team account after October 1st of any year will go to the PCSPMSA to be used for equipment and coaching development programs. If the fundraising is for a subsequent year the money will remain in the team account.

### LOTTERY LICENSE APPLICATIONS

- a) All teams conducting fundraising through the sale of tickets, or any other form of lottery must first receive a lottery license by submitting the proper Service NL lottery application form to the PCSPMSA office.
- b) Once the lottery license is issued it will be forwarded to the team for use. All teams are required to submit the proper Financial Report to the office of PCSPMSA within 30 days of the close of the fundraising.



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- c) All ticket draw winning tickets must be posted online through the Association and the Fan Page on Facebook.
- d) Teams should expect to wait approximately two weeks for a lottery license once application has been submitted. Teams must follow all rules laid out by Service NL regarding the operation of the license issued.
- e) The Team Representative or Manager will proceed and have the tickets printed.
- f) The Team Representative or Manager will prepare a ticket ledger identifying who is assigned blocks of tickets for sale. All sold and unsold tickets must be always accounted for.
- g) The Association does not assume financial responsibility for the ticket lottery.
