

Ramp Game Sheet Cheat Sheet

- Ramp Gamesheets and Ramp Team accounts are the same
- TeamCode needs to be entered into the Ramp Gamesheet Front screen, it will ask for your teamcode once entered it will automatically upload games



 You will receive a game code for home and away games as well as gamesheet code to update and have access to officials information and game sheet. These codes will be located on your Ramp interactive admin under League games and will be available prior to your games.




- Your Head coach requires the home or away codes to update on ice roster and bench staff
- You will also need to give your refs their Officials code for the game inorder to start the game as well to have them sign off on the game sheet and input any incident reports.



- I strongly recommend teams to have a stopwatch or timer as you will need to input actual ice time
- Who ever is running your gamesheet will also need to add staff to the game sheet ie: clock and gamesheet



 Once both teams and officials have input their rosters and they have counted players (ref's usually do not bring their cellphones on the ice, make sure you have your device handy for the refs to use to do a head count)and signed off you will need to lock the rosters ... no Changes to ANYONE'S roster is allowed once the officials have



- Ready to start the game
- Make sure you have a spare page to track your information and it will be fast paced and you don't want to miss something. It is VERY important to track all goals, assist, shots on goal, penalties, goalie play time, length of each period


 Remember once the puck is dropped the very first time in the period to start the stopwatch or timer and you stop it once the buzzer goes at the end of each period. After each period you will add in your actual ice playing time.



- Always make sure you change the current period. If you do not your times for goals and penalties will not line up and you Egamesheet will be wrong
- Once a goal is scored you will need to add new goal into game sheet right on the front of the game information is the easiest way to enter goals and penalties


To enter Goals Here is Home Goal and Away Goal




Here is where you will enter Penalties




• Here is where you will enter your shots on goal after each Period.



• This is where you enter the Power Plays chances




If Timeouts are used here is where you enter it.




If your game has gone in to overtime make sure you have clicked off Game ended in Overtime

Once the game is over and everything is correct and everyone has signed off on the game including coaches, refs, gamesheet person You can now complete your gamesheet but make sure you have review everything prior to clicking complete

Aswell once you are comfortable you can also during your games click live score and this will make every input you do live on APHL website so people at home or where can see the update gamesheet as the game is happening
