To support our referees while also encouraging environmentally responsible practices, we have updated our mileage compensation policy for the upcoming Summer season. Referees who drive more than 15 km round trip to officiate a game will be eligible for mileage reimbursement (Provincial Government's standard mileage rate X 0.85).

Please note the following important details:

Mileage reimbursement will only be provided to referees who use their own personal vehicle to travel to and from the game. When possible, we strongly encourage carpooling as a way to reduce our environmental impact. Carpooling referees are not eligible for individual mileage compensation, only the driver. Reimbursement will be issued in a single payment at the conclusion of the entire Summer season.
