President Report

The sport of soccer and the PEI Soccer Association have experienced another successful year. Our clubs have been able to maintain a strong player base and the Association is on sound financial footing.

The Leagues operating under our sanction are strong. The Indoor programs and winter leagues continue to develop and are positive. The Indoor facility will receive a face lift with the turf being replaced by the supplier due significant defects. Sponsorship arrangements with Subway and Umbro remain strong. The GOALLINE network continues to develop and provide the Association with the tools to administer registration and scheduling. Key to success is clear communication with all members.

The U12 program had a great season and I had the great pleasure to watch the year end competitions with great representation from across the Province. As with any change, there is room for tweaks and improvement but overall reviews were favourable. Our job now is to ensure that the LTPD plan is strengthened at that level and successfully implemented at the lower levels so that we attract players to the sport and keep them.

Grassroots plan appears to being implemented by our clubs and being viewed in a positive light with the majority of clubs accessing the funding. The importance of the first years of soccer cannot be emphasized enough and we have to supply coaches with the knowledge and tools to make it challenging, interesting, and fun. Changes to funding from the Province may create some challenges in the upcoming year.

The Provincial Team Program will continue to undergo significant change with all players competing in an Atlantic competition and then, some chosen to compete on a regional team. Regional cooperation has ensured this avenue for developing our sport will continue. This Program is needed for player development, coaching development as well referee development. This program feeds the Canada Games program which has a four year cycle.

Our Association will host the U 14 National Club Championships in the Charlottetown area in October 2014. Chaired by Bill McKinnon, the volunteer committee are to be commended for their efforts. The teams representing our Association at Regional and Nationals this season had varying levels of success. These Club Championships are a test of endurance as well as skill. If, for example, you have a bye on day one, you play five days in a row. Teams have gained an insight into the level of preparation necessary to compete at these competitions.

Changes at CSA are causing headaches for our Region.

Again this year, the Annual Awards Banquet at the Rodd Royalty Inn & Suites was a huge success. Special thanks go to Peter Wolters and Nick Murray for their roles. The support from the membership has been phenomenal making it a very worthwhile endeavour. The Award of Life Membership to Gordon Wilson added to the special night. Although the banquet is viewed as a worthwhile event, the costs continue to rise so consultation with clubs will be taken to determine its viability.

Thank you to Peter Wolters and Jonathan Vos for their work on behalf of the Association. Working for a volunteer organization is never an easy task and both have handled it very well. Thank you to my fellow Executive members: Fred Foster, Tammy Wall, Kirk McAleer, Mike Goeseels, John O'Brien, Bruce Norton, & Jim Chandler for your support. Rachel Beck Colwill has step down as Board member responsible for Women's soccer but her efforts on the Women's side was truly appreciated and efforts on the growth of game through the Provincial survey is also recognized. Tammy Wall has served her term and her efforts were truly appreciated, she has decided to not to re offer. John O'Brien has provided great assistance and insight when he filled the vacant Youth Director position in 2013 but has decided to step aside and provide an opportunity for others.

Strategic planning is essential for any organization and PEISA will be engaging in this process in the Spring 2014 to guide the Association for the next 4 years.

Senior Men's Director Report

The Senior Men's League had another successful campaign this summer. All divisions were competitive.

PEI FC was the lone premier team playing in the New Brunswick League. At Nationals, PEI FC came 9th despite only losing one game and having a 4 and 1 record.

Winsloe-Charlottetown Royals FC U-18 team had success in the senior men's Champion s League. They went to Nationals in Mount Pearl, NFLD and were very competitive.

In the Champions League, Churchill Trout of the Sherwood-Parkdale Rangers SC defeated Mussels and Bubbles of the Summerside United SC to win the George Barna Cup.

In the First Division, for the Provincial Cup, Sam's defeated the Panthers. Both teams are out of the Sherwood-ParkdaleRangers Soccer Club.

In the Second Division, Kensington defeated Morell to take the Diamond Shield.

United Panthers defeated Souris Lamplighters in the relegation game to earn the right to play in the higher league for the 2014 season. Kensington was unsuccessful against Dutch Inn United in their bid to climb back into the First Division.

The Senior Men's League continues to prove itself as a highly competitive league creating some fantastic games of soccer.

Youth Director Report

(1) Registrations in the U12 through U18 age groups for 2013 declined by 66 (3.2%) players from 2012. By comparison, registrations for these age groups declined 80 players (3.7%) from 2011 to 2012. Since 2000, youth registration has declined from 2,980 to 1,984 players, a reduction of 996 players or 33.4% over the period.

It is interesting to note that there has been a more significant decline in male versus female players over this period. In 2000, there were 1,437 (48%) boys and 1,543 (52%) girls registered. In 2013, there were 823 (42%) boys a decline of 614 (41%) players from 2000. There were 1,161 girls registered in 2013 accounting for 59% of registrations and a reduction of 382 (25%) from 2000. This is reflected in the number of teams for each age group by gender as detailed below.

Director of Officials Report

The past year was a little easier on our numbers than 2012. Having a year off from hosting national tournaments gave our referees time to relax over the Thanksgiving weekend.

We hosted the Atlantic U-14 All Star Championships again and were able to showcase some of our best and up and coming young officials. This tournament continues to be one of our main training tools. It allows us to give our young officials a chance to act as referees, assistants as well as fourth officials. No other Island tournament gives them this opportunity. All these games were assessed by our top assessors. These young officials did an outstanding job. The feedback they receive helps them to advance as officials.

We are already planning for the upcoming year which will see us again host the Atlantic U-14 All Stars as well as hosting the U-14 Club Nationals that will finish up on Thanksgiving Day. We will be looking for support from all our local officials as well as our counterparts in NB and possibly NS as the CSA typically sends only three National officials in for this tournament. UPEI will be hosting the CIS National Men's Soccer Championships in November. This will be officiated by some of the best National and FIFA referees the country has to offer.

lan Fradsham, PEI Referee Association Technical Director, will be offering Regional as well as District clinics in 2014. The refresher clinic will again be mandatory for all returning referees as mandated by CSA. Some of the information for these clinics will be outlined at the National Referee Director meetings in Toronto in March 2014.

Our registration numbers remain pretty consistent. Even though we had about 30 new referees we still ended up with just over 100 registered referees by the end of the summer. Retention is still an area of concern and we are looking into ways to better understand the reasons for this. Our returning number of first year referees was up a little and I think the credit for this goes to better support/monitoring our new referees and the Field Monitor program. Both of these programs shows the new referee that they have some support and gives them feedback to encourage them.

The Junior Referee of the year this past year was Zach Visser. Zach was involved in the U-14 All Star competition this past year in all three capacities: fourth, assistant and referee. He continues to self-critique and this helps him to strive to be a better official after each and every game. The senior referee of the year was Mark MacDonald. Mark has become one of the hardest working referees we have. He is always willing to take

on an assignment and has become a regular on the varsity lines showing great improvement.

A new referee payment schedule was presented at the fall board meeting along with a more realistic mileage compensation schedule. The mileage will continue to be issued from the PEISA office.

I would like to thank both the PEISA and PEISRA for their time and effort in working towards a better environment for referees on the Island. Both of these executives put a lot of time and energy into this great sport!

Competitions Report

During the Summer and Fall of 2013, soccer on PEI was again another busy time for PEI teams competing locally, as well as at Atlantic and National Club and All Star Championships. PEI sent a full complement of teams to all competitions. To all those coaches, managers and even the parents who committed countless hours in training, transporting and raising money to allow our players a chance to play our game, I would like to say thank you on behalf of the PEISA and congratulations for all your hard work, support and dedication.

The All Star competitions picked up where they left off in 2012 by sending Team Atlantic teams to the National All Stars for the U15 and U16 age groups. It appears to be the last time as the CSA technical department has cancelled the National All Star Championships for 2013 and probably for the foreseeable future. From the Atlantic All-Star Championships competitions held in Moncton for the U15 and U16 boys age groups and the U15 and U16 girls held in Halifax; the Team Atlantic All Star teams were selected to compete in the National All Star Championships held in Laval, QC (Boys) and Thunder Bay, ON (Girls). PEI was well represented at these Nationals with Melvin Sim Turay, Mon San Aung, James Foster and Blake deJong on the U15 Boys team and Brittany Timothy on the U15 Girls team. Jordan DeJong, Jake Deighan, Mark Smith and Alex O'Brien represented PEI on the U16 boys team and Jacqulyn Sudsbury was on the U16 Girls team. Congratulations also to PEI coaches Ashley McKenna and Jonathan Vos who were coaches on the Team Atlantic boys and girls teams at the Nationals. At the U13 age group, played in Corner Brook, NL both the girls and boys finished 4th. finished 4th. At the U14 age group played in Charlottetown, the girls and boys both finished in fourth place. Our All Star Program continues to develop fine soccer players.

At the National Club Championships held in October, PEI teams were off all across the country competing at their various age groups. The U14 Club Nationals were held in Lethbridge, AB with the Eastern Eagles finished 8th in a twelve team competition, while the Summerside United girls finished in 11th in a twelve team competition. The U18 Nationals were held in St John's, NL and the Winsloe-Charlottetown Royals FC boys finished 7th of ten teams and the Sherwood-Parkdale Rangers girls finished 8th in a ten team competition. At the senior competition held in Halifax, NS, the PEI FC men finished 9th of twelve teams competing while the Winsloe-Charlottetown Royals FC women team finished 9th of ten teams competing. Quebec City, OC hosted the Eastern Masters in 2013 with the PEI Masters finishing 4th out of six teams competing. I would also like to acknowledge the following people who represented our PEI teams as Provincial Reps at the various championships during the year: Bill MacKinnon, Thane Myers, Doug Smith, Donnie Taweel, Jim Chandler, Gerald MacDonald, and Kirk McAleer. Many thanks to you. I hope you enjoyed the experience as I am sure the teams did.

I also sit on the CSA Competitions Committee. As a committee, it is our role to approve the locations of the National Championships, report on the events, approve changes to the rules and levy fines as necessary following the competitions. Members from this committee are also

assigned the responsibility of being the CSA Rep at a National Competition. In 2013, I was given the opportunity of being the CSA Rep at the U14 National Club Championship held in Lethbridge, AB. It was a great experience being in charge of this Championship and I look forward to doing this again in the future.

Domestically, our provincials worked well again and will be covered under separate cover by our Youth and Senior Directors. It was encouraging to see the limited amount of call-ups requested by the respective Challenge Cup Champions. Teams are finally now realizing that Club Nationals are just that and requests for call-ups from other clubs will be kept to a minimum.

I would like to thank everyone who has supported me in this sometimes demanding position.
