The Coach Coordinator has a very important job. The Coach Coordinator makes sure that we have sufficient qualified coaches, and managers for each division.

List of Duties:

- At the beginning of the season, during registration, anticipate as best as possible the number of coaches required for a year.
- Contact previous year's coaches and encourage participation.
- Determine each coach's certificate and arrange for courses for all who need training. Courses are reimbursed by PLSC.
- Number of coaches required:
 - U5: 1 Coach and then 1 Assistant Coach for every 8 children
 - U7: 1 Coach and then 1 Assistant Coach for every 10 children
 - o U9: 1 Coach and then 1 Assistant Coach for every 12 children
 - U11: 1 Coach and then 1 Assistant Coach for every 14 children
 - U13: 1 Coach and then 1 Assistant Coach for every 16 children
 - U15: 1 Coach and then 1 Assistant Coach for every 16 children
- Each team will require a team manager (parent volunteer) who will assist the team with logistics (aka snacks, water, tournaments), leaving the coach free to organize games and practices.
- Ensure that within each teams Coach, Assistant Coach or Team Manager is a female that will be on the sidelines at all times to attend to female players incase of injury (ASA regulation)
