

The Field Manager is responsible for ensuring the fields are read for play. This involves primarily lining fields and erecting nets.

List of Duties:

- At the beginning of the year, the Field Manager will lay out and paint the lines on the fields of play. Typically, Lakedell School has three fields for U9-15 and two other fields for U5 & U7.
- At the beginning of the season, the nets are erected on the three main fields. These are kept up for the season and taken down at the end.
- Every other week the lines are re-painted as the grass is cut or rain reduces the appearance.
- The Field Manager will ensure that there is paint. A request is put in at the first club meeting of the year via a printed quote from the Co-op or Hanson's Paint to purchase paint for the season.
- Once funding via a grant or donation is secured the Field manager will make a motion at the second meeting to go and purchase the paint.
- The Field Manager is responsible for purchasing, submitting receipts for reimbursement and picking up the paint.
