

Jersey Responsibility, Return & Damage Policy

Approved by PMBA Executive: January 15, 2026

Applies to all Baseball and Softball Divisions

Purpose

This policy outlines the responsibilities of players and families regarding the return and condition of jerseys issued by Ponoka Minor Ball Association (PMBA). It ensures fairness, accountability, and protection of association property.

1. Responsibilities

PMBA jerseys are the property of the Association and must be returned in clean, acceptable condition at the end of each season. Each player is responsible for returning their assigned jersey to the team manager or designated uniform coordinator within **two weeks** following the conclusion of their final game.

Players and parents/guardians are expected to care for uniforms appropriately and avoid damage beyond normal wear.

2. Damage & Replacement Fee

If a jersey is **not returned** or is returned with **excessive damage** (including rips, permanent stains, or alterations), a **replacement fee of \$65.00** will be applied.

This fee reflects the current replacement cost and is subject to adjustment as pricing changes. PMBA reserves the right to waive or reduce this fee in exceptional circumstances, at the discretion of the Executive.

3. Unpaid Fees & Registration Impact

If the replacement fee is not paid by the end of the season, the amount will be added to the player's registration balance for the following year.

Players will not be permitted to register or participate in the following season until the outstanding balance is paid in full.
