

Ponoka Arena Guidelines



All Ponoka Minor Hockey participants and visitors are required to follow the guidelines set forth by the Ponoka Arena and PMHA. As per current AHS regulations, the Town of Ponoka Arena is operating at 1/3 of our building fire code.

Guidelines for Teams

All team players & team officials are required to:

- Wear masks at all times when not on the ice
- Use available hand sanitizer upon entering the building
- Maintain 2-meter Physical distance from those in other households except while engaged in physical activity.
- Stay home if they are feeling unwell or experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.
- Time Keepers will be required to wear a mask at all times.

Dressing Room Access:

Teams will have access to dressing rooms 30 minutes prior to the start of their game time. We ask that you vacate dressing rooms 30 minutes after. Showers are open, if time allows.

Maximum capacity in change rooms is 20. Teams will be given 2 change rooms if time allows.

Warm Up/Cool Down:

Currently, there is no extra space for warm ups or cool downs. Teams are welcome to use their change rooms or outside to do this.

Access to Water Bottle Fill Stations:

Each dressing room has a faucet for filling water bottles. The lobby water fountain is also available at this time.

Skate Sharpening:

Skate sharpening is available depending on independent operators' hours of operation. Skate Sharpening is located upstairs above dressing room #1 at the east end of the small ice surface.

It is the discretion of the facility and PMHA to ask families/spectators to leave the arena if these guidelines are not followed

Guidelines for Spectators

All spectators are required to:

- Wear masks at all times when inside the arena
- Use available hand sanitizer upon entering the building
- Maintain 2-meter Physical distance from those in other households
- Stay home if they are feeling unwell or experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.

Large Ice Surface Seating Restrictions:

- Maximum capacity for the large ice surface is 100 total spectators.
- The home team will be allowed 50 spectators
- The visiting team will be allowed 50 spectators.
- Maintain 2-meter Physical distance from those in other households

Small Ice Surface Seating Restrictions:

- Maximum capacity for the small ice surface is 50 total spectators.
- The home team will be allowed 25 spectators
- The visiting team will be allowed 25 spectators.
- Maintain 2-meter Physical distance from those in other households

Children not participating in on ice activities:

Children must be under the direct care and supervision of a parent or guardian at all times.
Children are not to be left unattended.

Hand Sanitizers:

Hand-sanitizers will be located throughout our facilities for your use. The Town will continue with enhanced cleaning of high touch surface areas and public washrooms in all Town facilities

Washrooms:

There will be hand sanitizer located outside of each washroom.

Concession:

Our concession is available depending on independent operators' hours of operation.

It is the discretion of the facility and PMHA to ask families/spectators to leave the arena if these guidelines are not followed
