Masks

If you can't afford masks, please contact AHS and they will gladly provide you with some. If you are just flat out refusing to make a point - please don't bother coming into the arena. Let a member of the association know that you are refusing to enter the arena with a mask, and we will arrange to take care of your player for you. Just drop them off and we'll go from there (of course with prior arrangements).

We in Ponoka are far more fortunate than some communities where they are requiring proof of vaccination to enter the building. Ponoka Minor Hockey is pleading with all of it's members today, **PLEASE WEAR THE MASK AND KEEP OUR SPORT GOING???**

If you do have a mask exemption from your doctor, please carry with you at all times in case you're asked - this may be a requirement at some arenas.

At our monthly meeting last night, during the Referee Director's report, it was revealed that our roster of Junior and Senior Officials used to average at 40. 20 Junior, and 20 Senior. This year, we are averaging 8. This led to a discussion as to what is the cause in the decline of interest in reffing the game. Unfortunately, the discussion centered around how badly the young people, or seasoned, are treated by both coaches and parents. This isn't a new discussion, but a reminder to our members that we actually do need refs on the ice to play the game. And, as such it is up to us to (even when we don't agree) stand behind the referee's decision. We can respectfully question decisions, but respect is the key word here. When our referees feel threatened, unsafe, unwanted on the ice, why would they bother putting in their time to keep our games going? As we head into this season, please remember to respect the refs at all times. And, while you're at it, encourage your player to learn how to ref. They can earn money and improve on their skills on the ice. Lets as an association shift our culture and welcome officials back on to the ice.
